The new One GT luxury boutique hotel is being hailed as a welcome addition to Cayman's tourism product and the revitalisation of the capital.

What 'Drives' the Price of Gas in Cayman

Much of the debate in the Cayman Islands around gas prices centres on Middle Eastern tensions and the war in Iran. However, some argue that this should not be a determining factor locally since the Islands do not get their fuel from that region.

Former Ofreg officer Dwayne Ebanks, who was the only Fuels Inspector serving all 3 Islands from June 2013 to May 2023, noted that since gas is purchased in America, prices here should not be subject to the uncertainty of war in Iran. He feels that the authorities in the Cayman Islands should not be overly focused on the situation in the Middle East, as has been posited in the press by some public officials.

"Ofreg CEO claims that the Ofreg office, namely Ofreg Fuels Sector, is monitoring the current Middle East situation," he noted, adding that, "This is not necessary since the fuel that comes to the Cayman Islands is more closely linked to America."

However, in an exclusive discussion with the Caymanian Times, Rubis gas station operator, Prentice Pantan, explained that the situation was not as basic as that assertion might imply. He said a more pragmatic view can be found in the cascade of chain reactions that world events have, not just on the supply but also on suppliers.

"The blockade in that region (the Middle East) has meant that the US are the only



suppliers left for most other parts of the world in most cases, and as a simple matter of economics, when demand increases, so does price," noted Mr. Pantan,

He added that the owners of retail fuel stations in the Cayman Islands do not set the prices at the pump, but are subject to the rates imposed by the parent company's Rubis and Sol, respectively.

"The gas business is much different than any other business I have been in because unlike other businesses, if your prices don't

go up immediately when prices rise globally, it is much more expensive to repurchase and the margins make it even more difficult. On top of that, there is only a certain amount you can raise your price to after repurchasing to make up for any shortfall experienced when repurchasing," explained Mr. Pantan.

Issues 'fuelling' the local debate

Dwayne Ebanks said, as the regulator, Ofreg should know what the cost to purchase fuel and ship it is for the parent companies and publish those numbers. He said this would better inform the buying public about the true picture of what is actually moving the price of gas so high in Cayman (just under CI\$7) in some instances.

"The government needs to implement some price controls via consumer protection legislation so that the regulator can have more authority in relation to what is charged for gas," Mr Ebanks suggested.

He said publishing all the numbers regarding costs and general mark-up would be essential for legislation that is based on transparency.

Though Mr Ebanks' assertion that gas prices in Cayman should not be as high in contrast to prices in the United States, Mr Pantan explained that there is shipping to consider, which adds to the disparity.

He said that he had just returned from Miami, where he had US\$ 6.39 at the pump. According to the Rubis gas station operator, gas retailers in Cayman get a price list with two to three days lead time, and he concurred that retailers in the Islands' industry are not privy to what the parent

company is paying for the gas or what their mark-ups are.

"Ofreg would have that information," he agreed.

Bank fees for transactions also hurt gas retailers, and bank fees on higher sales eat into profits.

The conundrum gas station owners face, according to Mr. Pantan, is that the more gas that is sold, the more of the already tight profit margins goes to bank fees.

"X percentage of a smaller amount is less than 'X percentage' of a greater amount," he noted.

On the other end of the spectrum, Mr Pantan said higher prices usually mean people become more conscious about driving and drive less, so there is less business.

"The price of gas and the perception of the public affects a lot of areas people don't think about and you also get a lot more cases of people driving off without paying when gas prices rise."

Other perspectives suggest that legislation may be the only relief for consumers of gasoline products in the Cayman Islands, but even that is a complex issue which will involve several entities and industries.

As gas prices continue to soar to some of the highest prices ever in the Cayman Islands, the government has been exploring ways to cushion the burden on consumers by discontinuing duty on gas, diesel, and propane.

The CI\$ 9 million package, which is essentially an emergency measure, will run for four months (June to September) and will also introduce a CI\$ 0.18 cap per kilowatt hour on CUC and Island Energy charges.

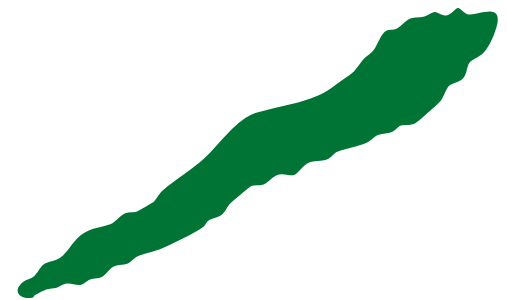

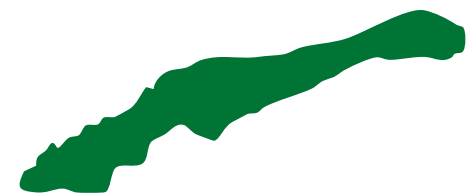

“From this rooftop you see exactly what we set out to create; a hotel that honours Cayman, elevates the guest experience and adds something truly exceptional to George Town,” noted One GT representatives.

Developer and investor Jeremy Hurst

praised the talent of all the team members who helped to bring One GT to life and talked about what made the development so unique.

“At 144 feet above sea level, that’s a first in Cayman’s history among many others for the site and the reason we call it One GT is because of those firsts. The first luxury boutique hotel with residences, the first

for George Town and the first of this elevation,” he noted.

A journey

Mr Hurst added that the journey to build One GT was not an easy one.

“Our journey started about 7 years ago when we first identified the site, which was actually first pitched as a five-storey-

office block. We took a bit of a risk and seven years later we finally stand here today on top of something that we as developers are tremendously proud of One GT.”

He said the journey was not one that could be embarked upon alone and thanked the Cayman Islands Govern-

ment(CIG), and in particular the Ministry of Planning and its Minister, the Honourable Jay Ebanks, as well as the incoming Deputy Governor Gloria Nixon and Colin Lumsden from the George Town revitalisation project.

Cayman connections

The site where One GT stands today was once a watering hole according to historical maps, and Mr Hurst said the community ties in the area were the reason the local residents in the general vicinity were the first to see the plans.

“It’s our connections to the Cayman community, its heritage and its past that is equally important to us. These are the foundations One GT is built on and we believe will ensure its success in the future,” he remarked.

“We’ve attracted owners from all across the spectrum of Cayman with a diverse range of backgrounds; from international investors, family offices, to resident professionals and local owners,” said Mr Hurst.

“Not only are we aiming to be the tallest building but we want to have the best product,” he added.

“We want you to enjoy the Italian bakery at street level, savour some of the finest gastronomy in the region at our signature French restaurant, Pearl and use our board rooms, meeting rooms for bookings of seminars and corporate retreats or cocktail parties.

In addition, Mr Hurst said the property is ideal for staycations. There is also a sauna, gym, wellbeing area, and lots more to be explored at the new site.”

With 97 units in One GT’s hotel programme for short stays, the site has also just launched a mid-to-long-term rental programme for a limited number of 2,3 or 4 bedroom units.

Welcome addition

Her Excellency, Governor Jane Owen, told the audience it was just amazing to see the building come together.

“I feel we are standing on a really important landmark for George Town. We are working so hard to revitalise George Town and this is a great step in that direction. Everyone in the Government building is looking forward to having a place to come, and this is a place that is going to be open to the whole community.”

Governor Owen also sees the new facility as an welcome addition to Cayman’s tourism product and listed several aspects that it brings. “I feel what One GT will bring to the Cayman Islands is a place that is a real magnet. It will enhance our tourism offer, enhance what workers and the public can do during their working day, offer something exciting for persons who come for short-term stay, and it will demonstrate what we can do with really beautiful and top-class architecture and design.”

The Cayman Islands Government's Quarterly Financial Report for the Three-Month Period Ended 31 March 2026 was published in the Cayman Islands Gazette on Friday, 8 May 2026 as required by law.

The unaudited financial results for the First Quarter 2026 show a \$321.7 million surplus for the Core Government and a \$328.1 million surplus for the Entire Public Sector (EPS).

Net Assets of the Government were \$2.9 billion, with overall bank account balances of \$722.6 million in cash and deposits.

Surplus

The overall EPS Surplus of \$328.1 million was \$58.3 million or 22% greater than the projected year-to-date operating surplus of \$269.7 million.

This favourable position was mainly due to actual revenues being higher than budgeted by \$40.4 million for the period, with coercive revenues accounting for \$35.2 million.

Year-on-Year Comparison

Comparing year-on-year numbers, the EPS Surplus was \$60.0 million higher than that achieved for the same period in 2025.

Statutory Authorities and Government-owned Companies' (SAGCs) results through the first quarter of 2026 showed a positive variance of \$0.4 million when compared to the same period in 2025.

Revenues

The first three months of 2026 generated revenues of \$624.9 million, which was \$40.4 million more than budgeted expectations and \$70.7 million higher than the 2025 year-to-date actual results.

The positive variance in Q1 2026 revenues compared to budget is mainly due to the favourable variance of \$35.2 million in coercive revenues, which can be broken down as follows:

- Mutual Fund Administrators Fees were \$8.3 million higher than budgeted and Private Fund Fees were \$7.9 million higher than anticipated, due to an increase in the volume of funds registered. The current year results for these fees are \$9.3 million and \$10.0 million higher, respectively, when compared to actual results for the prior year-to-date performance.
- Other Company Fees – Exempt Companies were \$5.7 million higher than the \$111.3 million expected budgeted amount for the first quarter due to increased registration. When compared to prior year-to-date performance, the 2026 results were \$7.0 million better.
- Partnership Fees exceeded budget by \$3.7 million owing to higher than an-

anticipated registration in this category. Compared to the prior year actual there is a \$4.6 million positive variance.

It should be noted that the aforementioned fees are regulatory licences due at the beginning of each calendar year and, typically align favourably with the budget through to the first quarter and then stabilize for the remainder of the year.

Stamp Duty – Land Transfers were \$4.4 million higher than expected and Land Holding Companies Share Transfer Charges were \$4.0 million higher than budgeted due to an increase in the stamp duty rate from 7.5% to 10% effective 1 January 2026, in addition to higher volumes of property transactions coupled with increasing property values. The 2026 duties and charges of \$33.8 million and \$4.4 million are \$7.1 million and \$4.3 million more, respectively, than during the comparable period in 2025.

Notwithstanding the overall favourable results in revenues, when compared to the 2026 Budget, there were certain areas that fell short of projected expectations.

These included Other Import Duty with \$2.0 million negative variance, Motor Vehicle Drivers Licenses with a \$1.9 million negative variance, and Work Permit Fees with a \$1.9 million negative variance.

However, when compared to the results for prior year-to-date, Other Import Duties are \$4.7 million more and Work Permit Fees are \$1.9 million more. Motor Vehicle Drivers Licenses are on par with the same period in 2025.

The first quarter generated coercive revenues of \$605.5 million, which was 13%, or \$71.2 million, more than the first quarter of 2025 coercive revenue of \$534.3 million.

The majority of this change is attributable to higher Domestic Levies on Goods and Services with a \$51.3 million positive

variance, and increased Levies on Property with a \$10.8 million positive variance.

Total Investment Revenue produced \$6.3 million, which was \$3.4 million more than anticipated for the three-month period. Higher cash balances held by the Government have afforded larger values to be placed on deposit and this has increased income earned on investments.

Expenses

Expenses for the first three months of 2026 amounted to \$303.1 million. This amount was \$10.5 million less than the year-to-date budget of \$313.6 million. Compared to the prior year-to-date actuals, expenses for Q1 are \$11.2 million higher.

There were some savings against budget in Personnel Costs by \$11.2 million and Supplies & Consumables by \$11.6 million.

However, these savings were offset by higher than budgeted levels of expenditure in Outputs from SAGCs by \$3.7 million, Outputs from Non-Governmental Suppliers by \$5.1 million, and Transfer Payments by \$8.0 million.

The report noted that year-to-date savings in Personnel Costs and Supplies & Consumables may not translate into full-year savings and may be due to timing differences. Vacant posts and delayed projects will impact current costs reflected in Personnel Costs and Supplies & Consumables, respectively.

Performance of Statutory Authorities and Government Companies (SAGCs)

SAGCs recorded a combined net Operating Surplus of \$6.3 million for the first three months of 2026; which was \$7.4 million more favourable than the budgeted Operating Deficit of \$1.1 million and which had a positive impact on the overall surplus for the EPS.

Based on the most recent information

received from SAGCs, this favourable variance is mainly attributed to results being better than expected at Cayman Airways Limited, the Cayman Islands Airports Authority, the Cayman Islands Monetary Authority, and the Port Authority. These favourable variances were partially offset by the unfavourable performance of the Water Authority.

SAGCs overall performance for Q1 when compared to the prior year-to-date performance is \$0.4 million better.

Cash Position

Cash and Cash Equivalents (including fixed deposits with maturity durations not exceeding 90 days) were \$99.8 million and Marketable Securities (comprised solely of fixed deposits with maturity durations

exceeding 90 days but not exceeding one year) were \$622.8 million, for a total of \$722.6 million with respect to bank account balances.

Due to the significant cash balances on-hand, the Government continues to place funds on fixed deposits.

Conclusion

The financial report concluded that the First Quarter's performance has positioned the Government to be optimistic about its performance for 2026. However, as planned increases in operating and capital activities occur during the remainder of 2026, the current surplus (as of 31 March 2026) is expected to be significantly reduced.

MRCU Wraps Up Awareness Week as Regional IG Reel Competition Begins

The Mosquito Research and Control Unit (MRCU) is encouraging residents to keep the message of Caribbean Mosquito Awareness Week going by taking part in the Caribbean Public Health Agency's (CARPHA) Instagram Reel Competition.

Residents of the Cayman Islands who are 18 years of age or older are eligible to enter the competition, which will see two winners each receive an Amazon Gift Card valued at US\$500.

The reminder comes as MRCU wraps up a successful week of Caribbean Mosquito Awareness Week activities in Grand Cayman, which welcomed approximately 575 students and 50 members of the public.

The week's events included a live drone demonstration and guided tours of MRCU headquarters, giving visitors the opportunity to learn more about mosquito control operations in the Cayman Islands and the important role the community plays in helping reduce mosquito breeding.

Participating schools included Cayman Academy, Cayman International School, Clifton Hunter High School, Footsteps School, Marie Martin Primary School and Prospect Primary School.



Throughout the week, students and members of the public met with MRCU staff, explored equipment and technology used in mosquito control operations, learned about mosquito species found in the Cayman Islands, and received practical guidance on ways to reduce mosquito breeding around homes and businesses.

Visitors also learned more about MRCU's environmentally sensitive and data driven approach to mosquito control, including how research, surveillance data, observation sites and public complaints help guide operations across the islands. The activities highlighted the important role research plays in MRCU's mosquito control programme and how science and

innovation continue to support public health and environmental management in the Cayman Islands.

The activities also highlighted the importance of protecting pets and animals from mosquito borne diseases, including ensuring dogs and cats remain up to date on heartworm prevention.

Community awareness and public participation remain essential parts of effective mosquito control efforts, as achieving the best results requires a partnership between MRCU and the wider community.

The week's activities supported several Cayman Islands Government broad outcomes, including protecting the safety and wellbeing of people, strengthening environmental sustainability, and building stronger communities through public education and engagement.

This year's activities were well received, with strong participation from schools, families, members of the public and the civil service. MRCU hopes to continue building on that momentum through future outreach and educational events.
