

Beyond the Scar: Breast Cancer Survivors Showcase their Beauty

The Breast Cancer Foundation held its second annual Beyond the Scar event at the Indigo Hotel on 16th May in front of a sold-out, star-studded audience.

During the evening, 10 survivors of breast cancer modeled in evening wear, casual and swimwear in a show of strength, resilience and solidarity.

More than simply a runway event, Beyond The Scar brought together breast cancer survivors, medical professionals, creatives, volunteers and the wider community in a powerful celebration of resilience, identity and hope beyond diagnosis.

The evening's VIP guest was internationally recognised author, speaker and breast cancer advocate Christine Handy, whose presence added profound emotional resonance to the event. Handy, a former international model and breast cancer survivor, spoke openly about redefining beauty and identity after cancer.

A movie based on her life is set to hit theaters later this year.

"I have been involved in hundreds of cancer events and yours surpasses them all," she said, adding that the women who

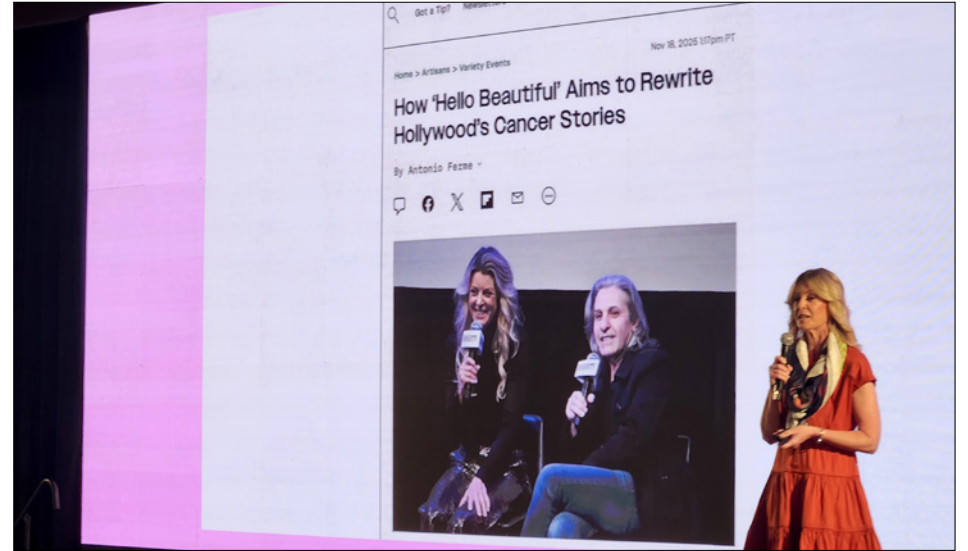
walked had an experience that will delight them their entire lives.

Chief Administrator of the Cayman Islands Breast Cancer Foundation, Beverly Edgington, reflected on the significance of the evening:

"Beyond The Scar was never simply about a runway. It was about creating a space where women could feel seen again - celebrated not despite what they have been through, but because of the strength, beauty and resilience they carry through it. Watching these women rediscover confidence in themselves has been one of the greatest privileges of my life. This evening reminded all of us that beauty is not diminished by diagnosis. It is deepened by it. Nor was it about raising money but more importantly we want to raise awareness and celebrate a life worth living!"

The creative vision behind the show was led by Creative Director Lauren Sonnen, whose deeply personal and emotionally charged curation shaped every aspect of the experience.

"These women give me absolute hope. Beyond The Scar was never just about fashion - it was about showing that no one should feel less-than because of what they have en-

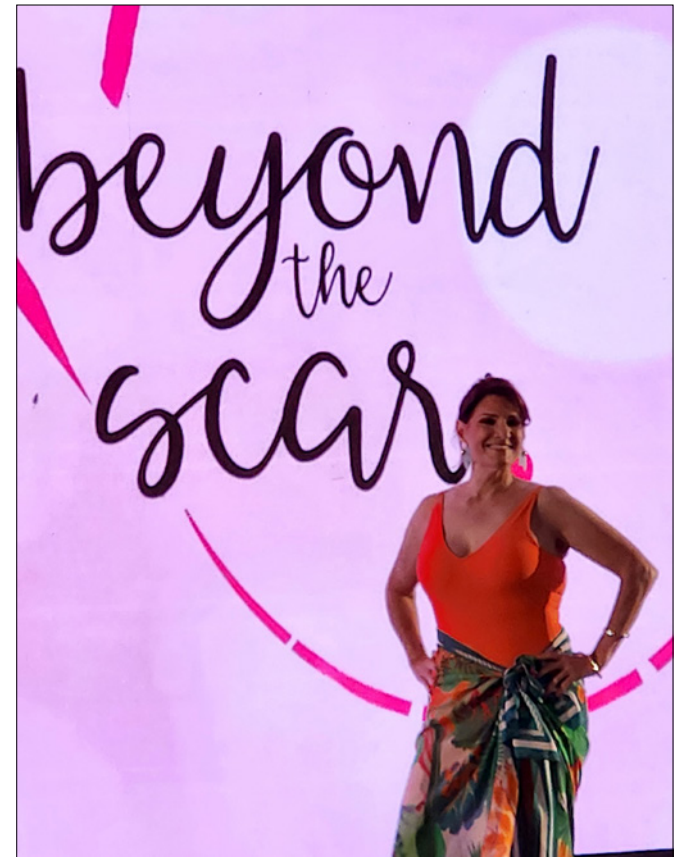

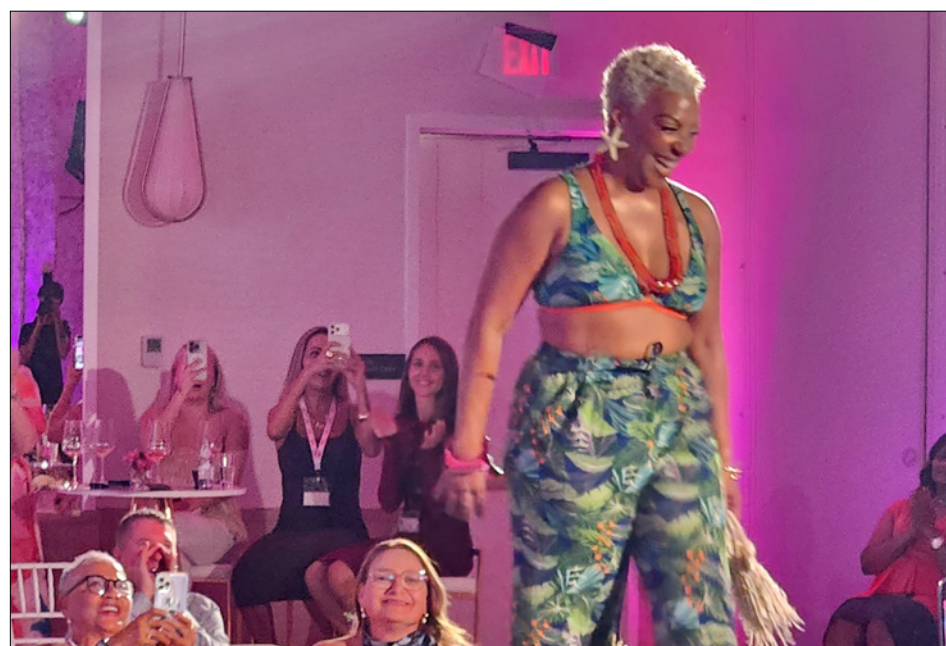
dured. Watching these women step into the light with such courage and strength was something truly extraordinary," she remarked.

Model Cindy Oostvogels noted that it was an honour to be a part of the event and explained that the night was an important part of the continued process of rebirth after the rigors of cancer treatment.

"I think of all the women who have had to go through this diagnosis and those who might not have made it. There are so many families that have been affected by breast cancer. It's a miracle to be standing here and all the more special to be able to represent all of the women whose lives have transformed misfortune into strength," she remarked.

MRCU Conducting Island Wide Daytime Larvicide Treatments

While larviciding will not completely stop all mosquito emergences, this proactive approach plays a critical role in significantly reducing the number of mosquitoes that eventually emerge.

The Mosquito Research and Control Unit (MRCU) will begin island wide aerial larvicide treatments across Grand Cayman on Monday, 25 May 2026, as part of its continued efforts to keep mosquito populations as low as practical through proactive, environmentally sensitive mosquito control operations.

The daytime operations are expected to continue for up to two weeks, weather permitting.

Residents can expect to see MRCU's aircraft flying at low altitude and making numerous passes over treatment areas throughout Grand Cayman during the operation. These flights are carefully planned and guided by operational data, field observations, mosquito trap collections, public reports, and ongoing research.

The treatments target mosquito larvae before they develop into biting adult mosquitoes. By interrupting the mosquito life cycle early, MRCU aims to significantly reduce the size and intensity of mosquito emergences across the island.

MRCU is now entering the time of year when more frequent mosquito emergences are expected due to seasonal conditions that create favourable breeding environments



for mosquitoes, particularly within swamps, wetlands, and other natural habitats.

While larviciding will not completely stop all mosquito emergences, this proactive approach plays a critical role in significantly reducing the number of mosquitoes that eventually emerge. Without these treatments, mosquito emergences would be substantially larger, more uncomfortable for residents and visitors, and would take much longer to bring mosquito numbers back down to practical levels through adult mosquito control operations.

The product being used is Altosid granules, a larvicide specifically designed to target immature mosquitoes in breeding

habitats. The product has been widely used in mosquito control programmes for many years and will not cause harm to humans, pets, wildlife, or the environment. MRCU follows all product label requirements and application guidelines, with safety remaining a top priority throughout all mosquito control operations.

MRCU's mosquito control programme is rooted in science, surveillance, and environmental responsibility. The Unit's data driven approach allows treatments to be strategically targeted to areas where they will have the greatest impact while minimising unnecessary environmental disturbance.

Unlike adult mosquito control operations, which target flying mosquitoes after they emerge, larviciding focuses on mosquitoes in their aquatic stage before they become biting adults. This proactive strategy helps reduce the overall mosquito population before it reaches nuisance levels.

MRCU is reminding the public that no special precautions are necessary during the aerial treatments. Residents may notice the aircraft operating repeatedly over certain locations as pilots carry out precise application patterns designed to ensure effective coverage of breeding areas.

The operation supports several of the Cayman Islands Government's Broad Outcomes for 2026 to 2028, particularly those related to Health and Social Development, Housing, Infrastructure and Environment, and Efficient, Effective and People Centred Public Services. Through proactive mosquito management, MRCU continues to support public health, environmental protection, and quality of life across the Cayman Islands.

MRCU encourages the public to continue doing their part by reducing standing water around homes and properties, as even small containers can create breeding opportunities for certain mosquito species.

GASTON BROWNE FAVOURS OECS POLITICAL UNION

The Prime Minister of Antigua and Barbuda, Gaston Browne, foresees an eventual political union of the Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States (OECS) - although he admits that it might not happen in his lifetime.

During his weekly radio programme, Prime Minister Browne asserted that the OECS is the hemisphere's closest group to forming a political union, even if the outcome extends beyond his tenure.

59-year-old Browne made the prediction following his party's resounding victory in the recent general election, which returned him to a fourth consecutive term in office with an increased majority at the helm of the ruling Antigua and Barbuda Labour Party (ABLP).

Antigua and Barbuda is a founding member of the OECS, which was established in 1981 with the Treaty of Basseterre signed in St Kitts and Nevis. The sub-regional intergovernmental organisation was set up to champion the interests of the then so-called Less Developed Countries (LDCs) of the wider CARICOM group. The larger countries - Jamaica, Trinidad and Tobago, Barbados and Guyana - were referred to as the MDCS (More Developed Countries). The original OECS treaty was revised in 2010 to establish the OECS Economic Union, enabling the free movement of people and goods.

The OECS countries also share a common currency, the Eastern Caribbean dollar (XCD), with monetary policy regulated by the Eastern Caribbean Central Bank (ECCB). Governmental oversight is done through the East Caribbean Currency Union (ECCU), presently chaired by Prime Minister Browne.

They also have a joint judiciary, the East Caribbean Supreme Court (ECSC), and other collaborative initiatives.

The Antigua and Barbuda leader is also suggesting another attempt at a jointly-owned



government airline to pick up from the failed Leeward Islands Air Transport (LIAT 1974 Ltd), which collapsed a few years ago.

"We're starting from now, not necessarily to drive a political union at this point, but to set the framework for one in the future so that future generations can take this thing to the next level," he said.

Presently, Antigua and Barbuda, in collaboration with Nigerian investors, operates a recently started regional airline service, LIAT20, which currently fills the void left by the previous LIAT 1974 Ltd.

Talk of an EU (European Union)-style arrangement has for some time been a background issue, especially regarding joint diplomatic representation and synchronised foreign policy. Although there is some coordination on critical foreign policy matters, the OECS member states

differ on several key areas of international relations. Some member states retain diplomatic ties with China in support of that country's 'one China' stance to include breakaway Taiwan, while others maintain direct links with Taiwan.

Recent major shifts in geopolitics, especially matters impacting the Caribbean and driven by the Trump administration in the United States, have brought the foreign relations issue into sharp focus.

Some observers argue that a harmonised foreign policy via a political union strengthens the status of the OECS, while others maintain that national diplomatic priorities should be paramount.

Montserrat is the only UK Overseas Territory in the Caribbean that's a full and founding member of the OECS. Anguilla and the British Virgin Islands (BVI) are Associate Members. Cayman, Bermuda and the Turks and Caicos Islands are not members.

CONSTITUTION REFORM ON ANGUILLA'S AGENDA

Anguilla is taking another serious look at its constitutional relationship with the United Kingdom. The ruling Anguilla United Front (AUF), which won the local elections in February 2025, empanelled a constitutional review commission last October and is now awaiting a draft report. Premier Cora Richardson-Hodge made the disclosure during a government press conference last week, indicating the issues that it anticipates will inform the ensuing public consultations.

"The draft will be reviewed, and then we'll proceed to public consultation, and I will keep you updated as things progress," she stated.

According to Premier Richardson, one of the issues expected in the preliminary discussions before any negotiations with the UK is the separation of roles between the Attorney General and the Director of Public Prosecutions.

"In many other countries, you have a DPP office that deals solely with criminal matters, and then you have the Attorney General's aspect that deals with civil matters. Right now, we deal with both civil and

criminal together, and so we want to separate the two," the Premier explained, adding that this issue was also included in the previous draft for constitutional reform.

The Anguilla Constitution Order, which originally came into force in 1982, was amended in 1990, 2019 and 2020.

PUBLIC CONSULTATIONS

According to Premier Richardson, with several members who sat on previous

reviews on the current commission, "So much work had been done before, and that work had been based on not just previous constitutions, but also speaking with the communities in terms of identifying what the communities want Anguillians want to see in the constitution."

While the government awaits the commission's draft report, based on which it

will put the issues out for public input, the broad matter of 'greater internal self-government' is anticipated to be part of the national conversations.

However, Premier Richardson only spoke broadly on that issue, referring to "a broad general framework in terms of putting together a constitution that would have showcased a greater internal self-government."

Another issue expected to command a lot of attention is that of the sensitive issue of diaspora voting in elections and how that is defined.

Many Anguillians, especially those in neighbouring islands, retain local addresses and remain on the voters' register. That was one of the hot topics in last year's general election.

"Whether or not Anguillians who are overseas ought to be able to vote - all of that would be part of a draft. I have not seen it. I have not had any one-on-one conversations in terms of any recent updates, but I anticipate that those are matters that will come up that will go out to public consultation," the Premier indicated.

Cayman Airways Marks Austin Inaugural as National Airline Continues Expansion

Cayman Airways launched its inaugural nonstop service between Grand Cayman and Austin, Texas, on Sunday, 24 May 2026, marking another step in the national airline's ongoing expansion and the Cayman Islands' broader shift toward strengthening stayover tourism.

The day began at Owen Roberts International Airport with a ribbon cutting ceremony, refreshments, and brief remarks before the early morning departure. Deputy Premier and Minister of Tourism and Trade Development, Hon. Gary Rutty, told those gathered that the occasion represented more than the opening of a new route. "We are celebrating progress. And partnership. And the achievement of another important milestone for our Islands," he said.

Rutty described Austin as a "vibrant, fast growing city" and an important addition to Cayman Airways' U.S. network. He emphasised that the new service reflects the continued growth of the Cayman Islands as a destination with global appeal. "For a small airline and a small country,

we continue to accomplish remarkable things," he said. "Cayman Airways continues to compete with much larger carriers, connecting us to key markets, and carrying the Cayman Islands flag with pride, professionalism, and excellence."

The new route is operated by the airline's Boeing 737 8 aircraft, the modern fleet introduced to replace the aging 737 300s. The 737 8 has been central to Cayman Airways' ability to open longer range U.S. routes in recent years, including Denver and Los Angeles. Austin now joins that list, enabled by the aircraft's improved range, efficiency, and capacity.

Upon arrival in Texas, there was a wonderful cultural display featuring the Swanky Kitchen Band and quadrille dancers. During the aircraft's two hour layover, airport officials joined Minister Rutty in delivering remarks to mark the occasion.

In his Austin address, Rutty highlighted the importance of the Texas market to Cayman's tourism industry. "In 2025, Texas represented more than 11.5% of all U.S. visitation to our islands, making it our highest performing U.S. state," he said. He noted that Austin alone account-

ed for roughly 14% of all Texan visitors to Cayman even before the convenience of

a nonstop flight. "That tells us that Austinites were already discovering and falling in love with the Cayman Islands. Today, we are making that journey faster, easier and even more enjoyable."

Rutty also underscored the collaborative effort behind the new service. "Airlift partnerships don't happen by chance," he said. "They are built through vision, collaboration, and a shared belief in the value of connection between communities and countries."

The Austin route aligns with the Cayman Islands' long term strategy to strengthen stayover tourism, a sector that has become increasingly central since the country moved away from pursuing a cruise berthing facility. New airlift is seen as essential to supporting small and micro businesses, expanding economic opportunities, and sustaining growth in the visitor economy.

As the inaugural flight returned to Grand Cayman on Sunday evening, the milestone stood as both a practical addition to the national airline's network and a symbolic marker of Cayman Airways' continued evolution. With its modern fleet and expanding U.S. gateways, the airline remains a key driver of the Cayman Islands' tourism future.

Berries (e.g. fresh, frozen and dried) are nutrient dense, rich in polyphenols, low in calories and are important contributors in diet quality. Berries contain dietary fibre, folate, vitamins (vitamin A, C, E, K and folate), carotenoids and minerals (calcium, potassium, magnesium, iron and selenium).

Berries are packed with essential nutrients and phytochemicals and have antioxidant and anti-inflammatory properties that protect your health and may help to reduce the risk of age-related conditions. Research evidence highlight their role in brain function, heart health and inflammation reduction.

Small but impactful

Berries such as blueberries, raspberries and strawberries are some of my favourite fruits. They are low on the glycaemic index as they contain dietary fibre and naturally lower in sugars, compared to other fruits. This blend slows down digestion, ensuring a steady release of energy without causing sudden spikes in blood sugar.

Nine healthy berries include cherries, blueberries, blackberries, raspberries, elderberries, cranberries, mulberries, blackcurrants and red currants.

Heart Healthy

Research evidence suggest that consistent intake of anthocyanins which berries contain, can protect heart health and may help reduce blood pressure and arterial



stiffness. A study including over two million people, found that a high intake of anthocyanins was linked to a 17 per cent lower risk of heart disease.

Boost your brain

Dr Uma Naidoo, a trained psychiatrist, nutrition specialist, professional chef and author, suggested that eating brain boosting foods like blueberries, can significantly decrease one's risk of developing neurological problems, improve your mental health and help you stay sharp and focused.

Research suggest that berries may help lower the risk of dementia. An analysis of 16,000 women in the Nurses' Health Study, found a higher intake of blueberries and strawberries was linked with a 2.5 year slower rate of cognitive decline in older adults.

Berries also protect our digestive health. Scientific evidence suggest that a plant based diet is best for gut health and berries play a key role in providing prebiotics and their beneficial anti-inflammatory and antioxidant compounds, help protect

the gut. I aim to eat a handful of berries every day.

A treat for diabetics

Although berries are sweet, their sugar content is balanced by the fibre included. Berries are suitable for people with diabetes, as they do not cause sudden blood sugar spikes.

Research conducted in the US, examined the impact of particular fruits on type 2 diabetes and found that people who eat three portions of blueberries a week, had a 26 percent lower risk of developing the disease which affects an estimated 580 million adults globally, living with type 2 diabetes.

Incorporating berries into your diet

Berries can be enjoyed fresh, in a beverage, dessert or condiment.

- Eat berries as they are, so grab a few blueberries for breakfast and include as a topping for porridge and breakfast cereal.
- Grab some berries as a snack. Eat as

they are or with low fat yoghurt, perhaps with a spoonful of muesli on top.

- Add fresh berries to a salad, especially black berries and blackcurrants, which give a delicious twist to a fresh green salad. Add nuts for a crunch.

- Mix berries into your smoothies. Blend a generous portion of fresh or frozen berries with banana, some kefir and a few nuts.

- Make berry condiments such as a berry compote, strawberry coulis, cranberry sauce and berry chutney.

- Eat berries for dinner, by including pickled cranberries with salads or salmon. Redcurrants make a delicious side dish.

- For dessert, round off with a berry filled fruit salad. Blend berries with frozen banana to make a berry 'ice cream'.

Storage of berries

- Store fresh berries in the refrigerator and don't wash them until you are ready to eat them.

- Store berries in a ventilated container as airtight containers may trap condensation.
