CIREBA representatives also emphasized the association's role in promoting professionalism, transparency, and ethical standards within the industry. They highlighted the advantages of working with CIREBA-member agents, who guide buyers through property searches, negotiations, and transactions while ensuring adherence to best practices.

Representatives from the Ministry of Finance and Economic Development outlined recent government initiatives aimed at improving access to homeownership noting that for first-time Caymanian buyers, stamp duty has been eliminated on properties valued up to CI\$550,000 and reduced to 3.75% on the portion of property values between CI\$550,000 and CI\$650,000. Second-time Caymanian buyers benefit from a reduced stamp duty rate of 3.75% on properties valued up to CI\$600,000.

Simon Watson of Charterland chartered surveyors provided an overview of the Cayman Islands real estate market, highlighting the sector's strong performance throughout 2025. He noted that while demand remains high, a robust pipeline of developments continues to create opportunities, particularly for first-time buyers entering the market.

PwC Cayman highlights AI-driven innovation at ReConnect 2026

PwC Cayman continued to participate as a gold sponsor in this year's third annual ReConnect 2026 conference. A review of the April event highlights how the technology is reshaping the reinsurance landscape.

Held at the Ritz Carlton on April 16-17, ReConnect 2026 saw a record attendance of almost 700 delegates this year, including local and international industry professionals.

The conference attendees included approximately 50% international delegates, including leaders from insurance and reinsurance carriers, brokers, investors, asset managers, and various service providers.

The first day of the 2-day conference included an impactful keynote speech by the Hon. Andre Ebanks, MP, Premier and Minister for Financial Services and Commerce, conversation with Cindy Scotland, CEO of Cayman Islands Monetary Authority (CIMA) and featured panels that highlighted Cayman's growing relevance as an offshore reinsurance hub, with topics delving into the growth of the sector on island, the evolving regulatory framework of the jurisdiction, as well as the practicalities of setting up a reinsurer. Some of the key points panelists focused on included the Cayman Islands' regulatory regime which they highlighted allows structuring and reporting to be more aligned with US expectations and practices, as well as optionality in deal structures where companies can find an optimized fit in accounting basis, reserving and capital frameworks and investment options for complex transactions, while still being subject to robust regulatory supervision.

On the second day, the conference delivered insights across various key industry



topics such as regulatory and actuarial trends, private assets in the insurance ecosystem, adoption and impact of AI, geopolitics and climate resilience.

A PwC subject matter expert, Jesvir Harkoo, Partner, Risk Modelling Services, participated on the AI in Action: Adoption and Impact in (Re)insurance panel, sharing perspectives about the role of AI in the industry. Jesvir highlighted that AI is no longer just an interesting side conversation, but a practical enabler on how companies transform and how they operate

post transformation. It allows companies to move faster and work through changes more efficiently. While being applied in areas of due diligence, deal structure, enhancing performance management, insurance forecast construction and balance sheet optimization, among others.

The panel participants also emphasized the careful and thoughtful way AI tools should be implemented in order for the solutions to be scalable and integrated in the entire end to end workflow, while noting the importance of keeping the human in

the loop where necessary to keep the process efficient and mitigate relevant risks.

Building on the momentum of the conference and continuing to spread the word about the growth of the reinsurance industry in the Cayman Islands, a PwC Cayman delegation, joined by other PwC representatives from across the globe, will be attending the annual Rendez-Vous de Septembre (RVS), the largest annual gathering for the global insurance and reinsurance market that will take place in Monte Carlo from September 5th to 9th, 2026.

DUTCH OPPOSITION PARTY WANTS TO SEVER LINKS WITH CARIBBEAN TERRITORIES

A heated exchange in the Dutch Parliament over its Caribbean territories has highlighted prevailing views in some European political circles about its remaining overseas territories.

The right-wing Dutch opposition party PVV (Partij voor de Vrijheid/Party for Freedom), which was part of a short-lived governing coalition from 2023 to 2025, is proposing that the Netherlands divest itself of its Caribbean territories, particularly Bonaire, Saba, and St. Eustatius.

The party, which was also in a minority Dutch coalition government from 2010 to 2012, has a history of antagonism towards the Netherlands Caribbean 'kingdom partners', viewing them as hangers-on and a burden on the Dutch government.

During a recent Dutch Parliamentary hearing of the Committee for Kingdom Relations, PVV MP Elmar Vlottes remarked that "one euro would still be quite a high yield" if the Netherlands as the mother country should divest itself of its Caribbean territories.

He further derided the islands' governments for doing little and only demanding money from the Dutch government. "They do little and when things get difficult they ask the Netherlands for a bag of money."

Asked by one parliamentarian if he saw anything good about the islands, Vlotte dismissively responded: "The weather is always nice there."

His remarks, which have been rejected by the Dutch government and political leaders in the Dutch Caribbean, came during a hearing into expanding the islands' councils/local legislatures of Bonaire, Saba and St Eustatius - also called Statia.

The Dutch Secretary of State for Kingdom Relations, Eric van der Burg, said he was "extremely disturbed" by the statements made by the PVV's Vlotte, telling him to "Be cautious if you have a beam in your own eye to talk about possible splinters from someone else."

STATUS

The three islands are the smallest of the group of Dutch Caribbean overseas territories. The others are Aruba, Curacao and St Maarten. Bonaire is located in the southern Caribbean Sea, while Saba and Statia are in the north-eastern Caribbean.

In a referendum in October 2010 called by the islands to determine their future relations among themselves and with the Netherlands, Bonaire, Saba and St Eusta-

tius (Statia) opted to further integrate into the Dutch administrative system, becoming specific wards or 'public entities'.

Aruba, Curacao and St Maarten voted for a status which closely resembles the arrangement between the UK and its Overseas Territories. However, unlike the UKOTs, residents of the Caribbean Netherlands who are 18 years or older and have Dutch nationality are eligible to vote in Dutch parliamentary elections. "By voting, they can determine who will represent them in the Second Chamber," according to Rijksdienst Caribisch Nederland (National Office for the Caribbean Netherlands), which is the link between the ministries that are present on Bonaire, St. Eustatius, and Saba.

REALITY

In a searing editorial titled "The reality is that the Caribbean parts of the Kingdom are worth far more than one euro. In fact, they are strategically priceless", the Curacao Chronicle newspaper came to the de-



fence of its sister Dutch Caribbean territories while challenging the assumptions of the right-wing PPV's Vlotte.

It wrote: "The Kingdom of the Netherlands maintains its presence in the Caribbean through Aruba, Curaçao, Sint Maarten, Bonaire, Saba, and St. Eustatius. These islands provide the Kingdom with a geopolitical presence in one of the most strategically important regions in the Western Hemisphere. Defence, maritime security, anti-drug operations, coast guard

activities, and international diplomacy all depend on this presence. The Dutch military maintains forces, naval assets, and security operations in the Caribbean precisely because these islands are strategically important. If the islands were truly worthless, why does the Kingdom invest in military facilities, naval operations, coast guard missions, border security, and international partnerships throughout the region?"
