RCIPS strengthens preparedness

The Royal Cayman Islands Police Service, over the last month, highlighted its ongoing commitment to continuous learning and professional development through the completion of an intensive Critical Incident Command Training programme for its officers.

The specialised training brought together a cohort of supervisory and senior officers to enhance their skills in managing complex, high-risk situations, including major emergencies, multi-agency respons-

es, and fast-evolving critical incidents. The programme focused on strengthening decision-making under pressure, strategic coordination, and effective leadership in dynamic environments.

"This training represents our commitment to ensuring our officers are equipped with the highest level of skills and knowledge," said Commissioner of Police, Kurt Walton. "In today's increasingly

Cayman and other British Overseas Territories, along with the rest of the United Kingdom, now have a new Prime Minister - and the OTs get a new Foreign Secretary.

Andy Burnham, until recently the mayor of Greater Manchester, has become the UK's latest leader following a rapid rollercoaster of events over the past few months. His accelerated trajectory to the leadership of the world's sixth largest economy makes Mr Burnham the UK's fifth Prime Minister in four years - and its seventh in the past decade. He is also the fourth Prime Minister to be presented to His Majesty King Charles III in his four-year reign since 2022.

Prime Minister Burnham's swearing-in on Monday followed a period of intense internal political upheaval in the ruling UK Labour Party, which culminated in Prime Minister Keir Starmer stepping down under severe pressure over his leadership, especially government policies - and policy U-turns.

The government's dwindling popularity amplified in recent local council elections, questions over economic management, the UK's persistent economic struggles, and Mr Starmer's declining popularity ratings also put his government in the crosshairs of its critics.

But Mr Starmer stood by his record in his farewell speech on Monday, saying he

was leaving the country in a better state than he met it when he took office after an emphatic victory in the July 2024 general election.

Meanwhile, in a brief address outside the official Prime Minister's residence and office at No. 10 Downing Street in London around lunchtime on Monday, Prime Minister Andy Burnham declared: "It requires my generation of politicians to raise our game and rise to the new challenge. Britain needs to show the world that we can regain our stability once again, and that is our challenge - to make politics work, to make it work better...We will make this moment a circuit breaker for Britain, bringing forward the biggest changes in the last 40 years - a

new political model and a new economic model."

Prime Minister Burnham also gave this commitment: "Later this year, I will bring forward a new plan for Britain, a 10-year plan, laying out a path from where we are now to where I believe we all want Britain to be, wherever we're coming from, whatever party we support."

NEW FOREIGN SECRETARY NAMED

Of particular interest to Cayman and the UK OTs in the changed political dynamics of the UK government is the Cabinet portfolio of foreign affairs which falls under the Foreign Secretary supported by a Minister of State.

In a major Cabinet reshuffle just hours after he took office on Monday, it was confirmed that Ed Miliband, who served as Energy Secretary in the Keir Starmer administration, is the new UK Foreign Secretary. He takes over from Yvette Cooper who has been reassigned as Health Secretary.

In a social media statement, new For-

eign Secretary Miliband who has responsibility for the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office(FCDO) under which the OTs fall, said: "The FCDO I lead will also be at the forefront of issues which pose profound and substantial threats to justice and equality in Britain and across the world. We will work with others on tackling the climate crisis, strengthening our partnerships for international development, and reforming our international institutions so they deliver for all countries, including the world's poorest people."

It was left to be seen who Mr Miliband will select as his Minister of State for the Overseas Territories.

Direct administrative linkage between the OTs and the Foreign Secretary is conducted via the Minister of State. The most recent post-holder has been Stephen Doughty, who was appointed following the Labour Party's resounding victory in the 2024 UK general election under former Prime Minister Keir Starmer.

Interestingly, Ed Miliband becomes the second member of his family to serve as UK Foreign Secretary. His brother, David Miliband, had the role from 2007 to 2010.

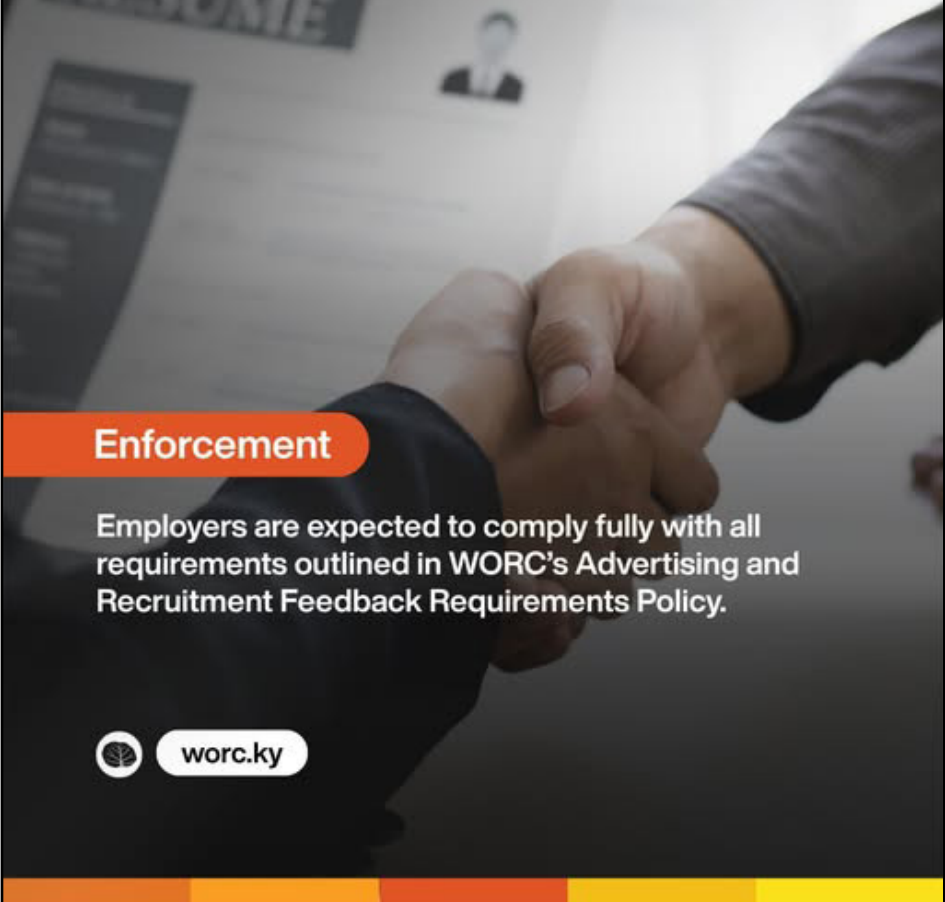

Police Investigate Serious Collision in Bodden Town

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Mentoring Cayman Celebrates Another Year of Transforming Lives and Building Cayman's Future

For more than two decades, Mentoring Cayman has been quietly shaping the future of the Cayman Islands by creating relationships that nurture and strengthen the next generation of leaders.

The Cayman Islands Chamber of Commerce recently celebrated the conclusion of its 2026 Mentoring Cayman programme with a Closing Reception at the Intergenerational Hub, bringing together mentors, mentees, parents, educators, sponsors and community partners to recognize a year of growth, achievement and connection.

While the reception marked the end of another six-month mentoring cycle, it also served as a reminder of the extraordinary impact the programme has had since its launch in 2002. Established in partnership with the Ministry of Education, Mentoring Cayman was the first structured mentoring programme of its kind in the Cayman Islands and has since created more than 1,000 mentor-mentee relationships.

Over the years, the programme has connected high-achieving students with experienced professionals from business, government and the wider community, providing guidance that extends far beyond career advice. Mentors share lessons learned through success and failure, helping young people build confidence, develop leadership skills, make informed life decisions and broaden their understanding of what is possible.

The programme's influence can be seen

not only in the lives of individual mentees, but across the wider community. Former participants have gone on to become accountants, entrepreneurs, managers and community leaders, while some have returned to support the next generation through mentoring and volunteer service of their own. Mentoring Cayman has also helped establish the value of structured youth mentoring in the Cayman Islands, paving the way for other initiatives and contributing to a stronger culture of community engagement and youth development.

Speaking at the reception, Chamber President Cristina Spratt reflected on the importance of giving young people meaningful exposure to career opportunities and real-world experiences.

"Throughout the year, mentors and mentees have had the opportunity to spend time together, discuss opportunities, gain a deeper understanding of different professions and get hands-on experience," she said. "It gives young people the chance to ask themselves: 'Is this what I want to do? Is this the path I want to take?' That kind of insight is invaluable as they begin making decisions about their future."

Long-time mentor Mary Reynolds, who returns year after year to support the programme, said the experience is equally rewarding for those providing guidance.

"I learn so much from my mentees," she said. "This is the fifth mentee that I've had,

and each one is a different experience. Each one brings their own perspective and culture to the table, which I love."

Reynolds said she encourages students to make the most of the opportunities available to them.

"I always tell my mentee on the first day that this programme is what they make of it. Its purpose is to expose them to different things and get them outside the classroom and into a real-world setting. That experience is incredibly important. The things they learn, the experiences they share with their families, and even a small spark of inspiration can stay with them for the rest of their lives."

For many participants, the programme helps turn uncertain ideas into clearer ambitions.

Mentee Zaina Doctor said the experience provided valuable insight into the legal profession through her mentor, Jackie Doak.

"I've learned a lot, especially about law, because my mentor is a lawyer and I've been able to see what Jackie does on a day-to-day basis," she said. "I came into this experience unsure about the type of law I wanted to pursue, but by seeing what she actually does, I was able to narrow down my interests and gain a much better understanding of the profession."

Mentor Roger Southam of My Realtor said his approach is centred on helping students pursue their own ambitions.

"I want to know where they want to go, what they want to be and what they want to achieve. It's all about what they want."

Southam described helping his mentee, Summer, pursue her interest in actuarial science by connecting her with professionals who could provide advice, inspiration and real-world perspectives.

For many participants, the relationships formed during the programme continue long after the formal mentorship ends.

Former mentee Diedre reflected:

"Over the weeks we got really close and I learnt a lot."

In her closing remarks, Programmes Coordinator Jada Ramoon celebrated the transformation she witnessed throughout the year.

"We didn't just witness a programme take place over the last few months; we witnessed transformation. We saw doubt turn into confidence, curiosity turn into ambition, and potential into pure leadership."

Rodri returns to top the elites

Spain captain Rodri must be one of the most unheralded players in elite football despite his impressive haul of accolades. He lifted the World Cup trophy to boost an already bulging trophy cabinet.

Already the proud holder of Ballon d’Or, one European title, one Nations League, four Premier League trophies, one Champions League and numerous other domestic triumphs, the Manchester City playmaker should be at his happiest.

When Spain beat Argentina 1-0 in the World Cup final on Sunday in New Jersey Rodri, 30, was also crowned player of the tournament.

Historic moment yet after rupturing his anterior cruciate ligament in 2024 there were doubts he would fully recover from such a serious injury. Yet he has bounced back magnificently.

If Rodri was the happiest, the most frustrated must be Kylian Mbappe who became the first player to win the World Cup Golden Boot twice after top scoring in America.

The France forward netted 10 times in eight games to edge out Lionel Messi’s eight in a high-quality race. Having struck eight times to finish top scorer at Qatar 2022, Mbappe, 27, has done it again. He is now the men’s World Cup all-time top scorer with 22 goals - one ahead of Messi.

A devastated Messi is still processing the disappointment of not winning the big prize again. He says “the pain is immense” and that it “will take time to heal”

Ferran Torres’ extra-time strike saw Spain crowned world champions for a second time, ending Argentina’s defence of the title. Messi has now lost two World Cup finals after Argentina were defeated 1-0 by Germany in 2014.

Messi, now 39, is unlikely to feature at the 2030 tournament, though he is yet to clarify his international future. “The pain is immense, and this wound will take time to heal. But I also hold onto all the good things,” he posted on social media.

At least the match nobody wanted to play in became the match nobody wanted to end.

England’s ‘bronze final’ against France was a thriller with 10 goals, six of them for the Three Lions. It had the feel of a training ground game - and there could easily have been more.

Bukayo Saka became only the second England player to score a hat-trick in a World Cup knockout match, after Sir Geoff Hurst in the 1966 final.

And it means England achieved their highest men’s World Cup finish since winning the tournament in 1966. And their best-ever result on foreign soil.

Highlight of that amazing game was Jude Bellingham’s brilliant individual goal for England’s sixth and his seventh in the tournament.

Such was the success of the 48-team tournament for the first time that Gianni Infantino, the much-maligned FIFA president, is seriously considering a 64-team World Cup Finals next time.

Infantino said: “If you don’t give smaller countries a chance to participate, they’ll lack the incentive to keep improving.” Another expansion means, of course, more games, money and worldwide TV revenues.

The likes of Cape Verde, Curacao, Jordan and Uzbekistan acquitted themselves superbly so another 16 teams would not be inconceivable.

Purely in terms of the competition format, it does make sense.

The top two teams in the 16 groups would go through to the knockout stage. No longer would there be a need to send a few third-placed teams through.

The 2030 World Cup will mark 100 years since the first World Cup, which was held in Uruguay.

The tournament will primarily be hosted by Morocco, Portugal and Spain, but the opening three matches will be played in Uruguay, Argentina and Paraguay as centenary hosts.

The furore generated by Argentina’s appalling behaviour after losing to Spain hasn’t abated. FIFA’s disciplinary committee has appointed a disciplinary and ethics prosecutor to assess what happened after

the final whistle at MetLife stadium.

Any player or coach involved in the fracas could face suspension, while the Argentine Football Association may also be fined.

NEW EAST CARIBBEAN BANKNOTES EXCHANGE QUEEN ELIZABETH FOR LOCAL NATIONAL HEROES

The Eastern Caribbean Central Bank (ECCB) has issued a series of redesigned banknotes replacing the late Queen Elizabeth II with selected national heroes from member states where the Eastern Caribbean dollar (EC/XCD) is the official currency.

In announcing the new designs, the ECCB said the objective was to honour the people, heritage and achievements of the eight member countries of the Eastern Caribbean Currency Union (ECCU). Announcing that the banknotes no longer feature the likeness of the late Queen Elizabeth II, Governor of the Eastern Caribbean Central Bank (ECCB), Timothy N.J. Antoine stated: "Recognising that the currency belongs to the people of the Eastern Caribbean Currency Union, the Monetary Council invited the public, through the Central Bank, to help shape this new chapter in our shared

history. The response was clear and compelling. The people called for our currency to honour our own heroes, nation builders, and persons whose lives and achievements have enriched our countries and strengthened our region."

The \$100 banknote, the largest denomination of the currency, features Sir Arthur Lewis (Nobel Prize for Economics, 1979), and former Prime Minister Sir John Compton, both of St. Lucia.

Appearing on the \$50 banknote are former Governor of the Eastern Caribbean Central Bank Sir Dwight Venner of St. Lucia, and Sir Robert Llewellyn Bradshaw, the first Prime Minister of St. Kitts & Nevis.

Antigua and Barbuda's first Prime Minister, Sir Vere Cornwall Bird and his Dominica counterpart, Dame Eugenia Charles, are honoured on the \$20 note, with the first Chief Ministers of Anguilla and Montserrat,

respectively - Ronald Webster and William H. Bramble - recognised on the \$10 bill.

The \$5 banknote features former St Vincent and the Grenadines Prime Minister Milton Cato, who led that country into independence, along with Grenada's national hero athlete Sir Kirani James.

Other changes include, for the first time, the ECCB logo encircled by the flags of the ECCU, with the likeness of Sir Dwight Venner now appearing on the front of the \$50 banknote instead of the back, while the image of Sir Arthur Lewis was moved from the back of the \$100 banknote to the front.

The redesign for EC coins replaces the likeness of Queen Elizabeth II on the front with the ECCU logo.

Some observers have pointed to the retention of the depiction of the Golden Hind vessel of British explorer Sir Francis Drake on the reverse of the 1 dollar, 25-cent, and

10-cent coins, citing his association with the Trans-Atlantic slave trade and colonialism.

The Eastern Caribbean Central Bank (ECCB) established in 1983, is the Monetary Authority for Anguilla, Antigua and Barbuda, Dominica, Grenada, Montserrat, St Kitts and Nevis, St Lucia and St Vincent and the Grenadines.

It is the central bank and monetary regulatory authority for the Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States (OECS). Its related organs are the Eastern Caribbean Currency Union (ECCU) and the Monetary Council. The EC/XCD dollar is the official currency used by its seven full members, which include the British Overseas Territory of Montserrat, and one associate member, Anguilla, another UK OT. It has an exchange rate of \$1 EC/XCD to US 30 cents or US1.00 to EC/XCD \$2.70



SEPTEMBER TARGET FOR BERMUDA ELECTORAL REFORM LEGISLATION

The Bermuda government is still hoping to table legislation on major electoral reforms by September this year. A government-appointed independent working group has been reviewing the government's plans and is expected to advise on its findings in the coming weeks.

The reassurance comes in the wake of changes to the group's membership and the minister to whom it was assigned when it was established last month.

Now charged with guiding the process through to its legislative stage is Rev. Emily Dill, the new Minister for the Cabinet Office.

Ministerial responsibility was previously held by Dr Diallo Rabain, the former minister for the Cabinet Office and Digital Innovation, who has been reassigned to the Ministry of Education and Planning in a recent Cabinet reshuffle.

Also, the original 11-person working group of cross-party representatives has been reduced by one due to time constraints cited by the ex-member.

New Cabinet Office Minister Rev. Dill has given an assurance of her full commitment to see the process through to presentation to the Bermuda Parliament.

The cross-party group comprises representatives from the ruling Progressive Labour Party (PLP), the One Bermuda Alliance (OBA), the Free Democratic Movement (FDM), and an independent candidate.

The issue of electoral reform ranks highly on the policy agenda of the PLP administration of Premier David Burt, now in his third term.

The current push for reform focuses heavily on absentee voting for eligible Bermudian students studying overseas. It also focuses on setting clear standards for political parties and campaign financing, modernising the electoral system with the use of technology,

ensuring the voters' register remains accurate, private, and transparent, and setting consistent and fair rules for polling day administration. Another key element involves extensive public consultations throughout the

territory.

According to the Bermuda government, "Electoral reform is about strengthening public confidence in Bermuda's democracy. It is about improving access to voting, ensuring elections con-

tinue to be conducted fairly and consistently, bringing greater transparency to campaign and election finance, and ensuring that the institutions responsible for our elections are equipped for the future."



Ministry Delegation Strengthens Public Health Partnerships at UK Overseas Territories Conference

Representatives from the Ministry of Health, Environment and Sustainability have returned from the UK Overseas Territories (UKOT) Public Health Conference with new knowledge, strengthened partnerships and practical insights that will help inform public health policy and planning in the Cayman Islands.

The conference, which took place in London at the end of June, brought together Chief Medical Officers, public health leaders and professionals from the majority of the UK Overseas Territories, alongside representatives from the UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA), the Caribbean Public Health Agency (CARPHA) and other partner organisations. Delegates shared presentations on their experiences, challenges and innovative approaches to addressing public health issues within their respective jurisdictions, providing valuable opportunities to learn from one another. The conference explored shared public health priorities, emerging challenges and evidence-based approaches to improving population health through prevention, collaboration and innovation.

The programme covered a broad range of topics, including health protection, emergency preparedness, prevention, health equity, behavioural science, community resilience and tackling health inequalities. Keynote speaker Professor Kevin Fenton CBE highlighted the importance of building trust through consistent engagement with communities and adopting system-wide approaches to improve health outcomes.

Chief Medical Officer Dr. Hilary Wolf said the conference reinforced the value of the Cayman Islands' longstanding relationship with public health partners in the United Kingdom.

"The UK Overseas Territories benefit significantly from the expertise, technical support and resources available through our partnership with the UK Health Security Agency and other UK organisations. These longstanding relationships enable us to share knowledge, learn from emerg-

ing evidence and strengthen our collective capacity to respond to public health challenges. As we continue to develop public health policy in the Cayman Islands, these partnerships remain an invaluable resource."

Chief Nursing Officer Ms. Felicia McLean said the conference highlighted the importance of prevention and strong community partnerships.

"Many of the discussions focused on prevention, health equity and community engagement. These are priorities that resonate in the Cayman Islands, and it was valuable to learn how other jurisdictions are working across sectors to improve health outcomes and strengthen community resilience."

As part of the conference's itinerary, the Ministry delegation participated in three site visits hosted by Lewisham Council and local health partners. The first visit was to the Lewisham District Office, where delegates learned about the borough's Health Equity Teams (HET) programme, an initiative developed to address racial health inequalities through partnership working. The second visit showcased the

North Lewisham Primary Care Network (PCN) and Red Ribbon's Healthy Hearts programme, highlighting collaborative approaches to cardiovascular health and community engagement. The third visit focused on the Lewisham Alliance PCN and Coco Collective's Plantain Programme, demonstrating innovative partnership models to improve health outcomes within diverse communities.

The visits provided first-hand insight into how sustained collaboration between primary care providers, local authorities and voluntary sector organisations is helping to deliver more equitable health outcomes and improve population health. Delegates also explored how these initiatives engage communities, build trust and use local data to target interventions, providing valuable lessons that can help inform future public health policy and partnership approaches in the Cayman Islands.

Policy Support Officer Ms. Halle Miller said the conference and site visits provided valuable opportunities to learn from colleagues across the region. "It was a real privilege to engage with so many

dedicated professionals and to learn from their experiences across the UK Overseas Territories. I leave with a renewed appreciation for the commitment of public health colleagues across the region, and I look forward to collaborating on future initiatives to strengthen health security and improve health outcomes across our territories."

Chief Officer for the Ministry of Health, Environment and Sustainability, Ms. Tamara Ebanks added that her support saying: "Our participation and presence at the UK Overseas Territories Public Health Conference provides invaluable experience to our policy teams, strengthens relationships with regional and international partners and provides practical knowledge that will support the development of evidence-based public health policy in the Cayman Islands."

The Ministry remains committed to working collaboratively with partners across the UK Overseas Territories and beyond to improve health outcomes, strengthen health security and build a healthier future for all Cayman Islands residents.

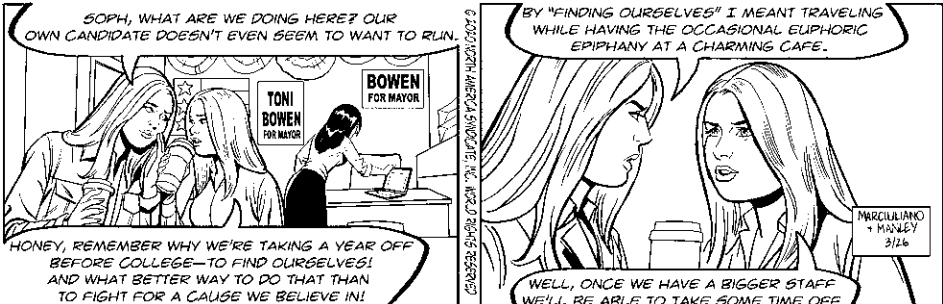

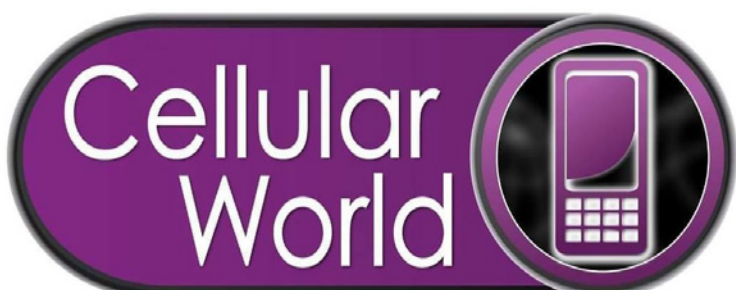
