In a scholarly commentary titled 'Culture is Currency', he argues that many Caribbean artistes and their respective countries are 'shortchanging' themselves.

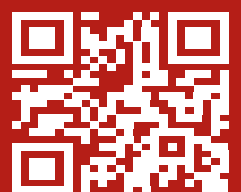

National Weather Service Director Retires After 41 Years

After more than four decades of public service, Director General John Tibbetts will retire from the Cayman Islands National Weather Service at the end of this month, bringing to a close a career of more than 41-years dedicated to strengthening the Cayman Islands' weather services and national preparedness.

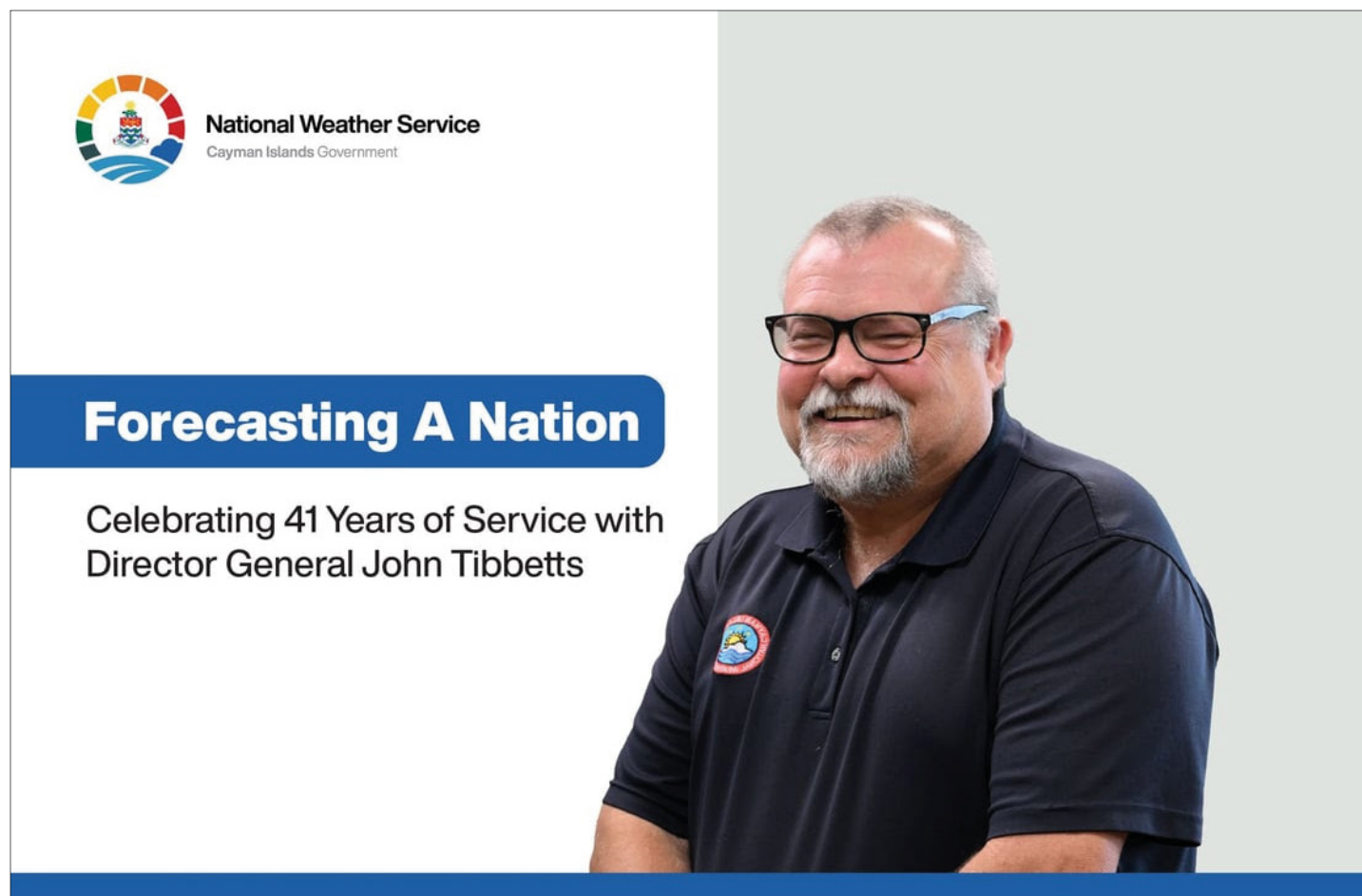
Having joined the former Department of Civil Aviation in 1985 – now the Civil Aviation Authority of the Cayman Islands – as a Weather Observer in the Aviation Weather Office, Mr Tibbetts has played a central role in transforming a small aviation-focused operation into today's National Weather Service, overseeing its growth in capability, technology and service to the Cayman Islands.

Throughout his career, Mr Tibbetts served in several operational and leadership roles, beginning as a Weather Observer before progressing to Operational Weather Forecaster and Chief Meteorologist, and ultimately being appointed Director General in 2014 following the retirement of longtime Director Fred Sambula.

Cabinet Secretary Samuel Rose said Mr Tibbetts' career reflected the very best of the Cayman Islands Civil Service. "Director General John Tibbetts' 41 years of public service bear testament to his unwavering commitment to the people of the Cayman Islands and to the highest standards of the Civil Service. Throughout his career, he has demonstrated exceptional professionalism, passion, and leadership, helping to build a National Weather Service that plays a vital role in safeguarding our Islands. He successfully developed a team that is recognised and respected throughout the Caribbean. His contribution to meteorological services both locally and regionally will have a lasting impact, and I wish him every success in his retirement."

During his tenure as Director General, Mr Tibbetts oversaw a period of significant growth and modernisation for the National Weather Service. This included the expansion of forecasting capability, observation systems, technology, staffing and regional collaboration, while supporting the organisation's transition from an aviation-focused weather office into a modern National Weather Service serving the wider needs of the Cayman Islands.

His leadership also helped strengthen



the Service's role in supporting national preparedness and emergency response, including through some of the Cayman Islands' most significant weather events, such as Hurricanes Gilbert, Mitch and Ivan. During this time, the National Weather Service continued to expand its forecasting capabilities, observation systems and public warning services in collaboration with local, regional and international partners.

"John's leadership has helped shape not only the National Weather Service, but also the people within it," said Chief Meteorologist Kerry Powery. "He has always been passionate about developing the next generation of meteorologists and ensuring the Service continued to evolve to meet the needs of the Cayman Islands. His vision, guidance and unwavering commitment have laid a strong foundation for the future, and we are proud to continue building on the legacy he leaves behind."

Reflecting on his career, Mr Tibbetts said it had been a privilege to serve the

Cayman Islands and witness the continued development of the National Weather Service.

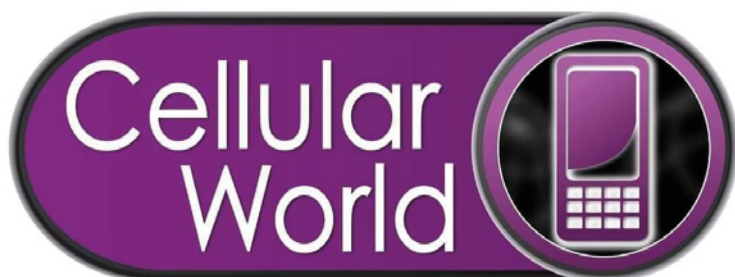
"It has been an incredible privilege to serve the Cayman Islands for the past 41 years and to be part of the remarkable journey of the National Weather Service," Mr Tibbetts said. "I have been fortunate to work alongside dedicated colleagues, regional and international partners, and to play a part in the transformation of the Service from a small aviation weather office into the organisation it is today. As I prepare for retirement, I do so with immense pride in what we have achieved together and every confidence that the Service will continue to grow, innovate and serve the people of the Cayman Islands for many years to come."

As he retires, the National Weather Service continues to build upon the foundations established throughout Mr Tibbetts' career, including ongoing investment in technology, expanded staffing, progress towards continuous 24-hour weather observation and forecasting, and the completion of its new headquarters later this year.

Premier the Honourable André Ebanks thanked Mr Tibbetts for his decades of public service and his lasting contribution to the Cayman Islands.

"John Tibbetts' contribution to the Cayman Islands extends far beyond the National Weather Service," said Premier Hon André Ebanks. "For more than four decades, he has helped strengthen our national resilience, modernise our weather services and ensure generations of Caymanians have benefited from accurate, timely and trusted weather information. On behalf of the Government and people of the Cayman Islands, I thank him for his outstanding public service and wish him every happiness and fulfilment in his well-earned retirement."

The Cayman Islands Government extends its sincere appreciation to Mr Tibbetts for his 41 years of dedicated service and wishes him every success and happiness in his retirement. Chief Meteorologist Kerry Powery will assume the role of Director General Designate ahead of his appointment as Director General on 1 September 2026.

US AND CARIBBEAN STATES BOLSTER SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS

The United States is bolstering its security arrangements in the Caribbean region with a series of agreements with several selected countries.

To date, agreements have been signed with Guyana, Trinidad and Tobago, and most recently Jamaica.

A joint statement between the US Trump administration and the Jamaican government of Prime Minister Andrew Holness describes the August 20th agreement as a Status of Forces Agreement (SOFA).

It said the agreement builds on the already strong bilateral security partnership acknowledged and discussed by United States Secretary of War Pete Hegseth and the Jamaican Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of National Security Dr Horace Chang during their bilateral meeting in the margins of the Americas Counter Cartels Coalition Forum in Panama on August 12th.

Status of Forces Agreements(SOFA) are described as international instruments that establish and formalise the terms under which members of one country's armed forces may be temporarily present in another country for mutually agreed activities, including training exercises and joint operations. Jamaica joins more than 120 partner nations that have similar agreements with the United States.

"Jamaica and the United States have enjoyed decades of close security cooperation." Since the establishment of the Jamaica Defence Force (JDF), members of the United States Armed Forces and JDF have participated in joint training exercises, professional exchanges, humanitarian and disaster response activities, and other forms of security cooperation," the statement said.

"This SOFA agreement is a message to the criminal organisations in the region that the United States Armed Forces and JDF are committed to deepening and expanding their cooperation, including in their efforts to fight criminal organisations and narco-terrorists who traffic guns, drugs, and people."

Earlier in August, the government of Guyana under President Irfaan Ali inked a Memorandum of Understanding(MOU) with the US, upgrading their existing Memorandum of Security Cooperation.

"The MoU strengthens and deepens the long-standing partnership, building on earlier cooperation in countering narcotics and wider security collaboration," a release from the Office of the Guyanese President explained.

In a separate statement on security and related issues between the two countries, President Ali said: "Our discussions focused on strengthening the Guyana-US partnership and advancing our shared interests in prosperity, security and regional stability...I also reaffirmed Guyana's commitment to working closely with the United States to combat drug trafficking and transnational organised crime, strengthen security cooperation, and uphold respect for territorial sovereignty."

Last December 2025, Trinidad and Tobago's Ministry of Foreign and CARICOM Affairs reported that it had 'reaffirmed' its commitment to sustained cooperation with the United States in advancing regional safety, security, and stability.

"Through this partnership, Trinidad and Tobago has benefited from joint military training exercises, enhanced surveillance capabilities, including the installation of an effective radar system, and collaborative efforts that have contributed to the interdiction of millions of dollars' worth of illegal narcotics."

These agreements fall broadly under the Trump administration's Shield of the Americas (SOTA) operation, a multinational military and political coalition established by the US President in March this year.

Participating countries in the region at varying levels of involvement are the Bahamas, Belize, the Dominican Republic, Guyana, Jamaica, and Trinidad and Tobago.

Chamber Lunch & Learn Encourages Open Conversation on Menopause and Women's Wellbeing

GRAND CAYMAN, Cayman Islands – The Cayman Islands Chamber of Commerce welcomed members and guests to a thought-provoking Lunch & Learn session, "Let's Talk About Menopause," on 12 August 2026 at the Chamber Conference Room.

Presented by Dr. Martinez in association with the British Menopause Society, the session explored the physical, emotional, and professional impacts of perimenopause and menopause, providing attendees with practical, evidence-based information on symptom management, treatment options, and overall wellbeing.

Dr. Martinez emphasized the importance of raising awareness about hormonal changes and their effects on women's work lives, family responsibilities, and quality of life. "Women don't have to struggle with menopause symptoms. There is help available," said Dr. Martinez. "Treatment must be individualized, so it's important to talk to a doctor who is knowledgeable about menopause and the options available."

The session highlighted a range of effective approaches to symptom management, including lifestyle changes such as regular exercise and healthy nutrition, mind-body therapies, cognitive behavioural therapy (CBT), and emerging treatment options. Attendees also learned about new FDA-approved non-hormonal medications, including Fezolinetant, as well as the benefits of combining different treatment strategies to achieve the best outcomes.

Key messages from the discussion included the importance of personalized care, the effectiveness of non-hormonal treatment options for many women, and the value of working closely with healthcare professionals to develop an approach tailored to individual needs.

The Chamber thanks Dr. Martinez for leading an informative and engaging discussion on a topic that affects women in the workplace, at home, and throughout the wider community.

By fostering greater understanding and awareness, the session encouraged open dialogue and reinforced the importance of

supporting women's health and wellbeing at every stage of life.

National Recognition Awards Committee Begins Planning

The Cayman Islands' financial services industry will take centre stage at the 2027 National Heroes Day ceremony, after Cabinet confirmed "Financial Services" as the event's theme. The National Recognition Awards Committee has now convened to begin planning for the ceremony, which will be held on Monday, 25 January to recognise individuals and organisations that have contributed to the development and growth of the Islands financial services industry.

Speaking on the significance of the event, Minister for Youth, Sports, Culture and Heritage Honourable Isaac Rankine said, "National Heroes Day exists to remind us that nation-building is the work of many hands, across all three of our islands. This year's focus on financial services broadens that story, recognising individuals and organisations whose steady contribution over the years has strengthened our economy and global reputation. I look forward to seeing the nominations come in and to

celebrating, as a country, the people behind this remarkable achievement."

Premier and Minister for Financial Services and Commerce, Honourable André Ebanks reflected on the choice of financial services as this year's theme, "Financial services has been the single most transformative force in our nation's modern development, not by accident, but through the vision, discipline and hard work of individuals and organisations across Grand Cayman, Cayman Brac and Little Cayman.

This year's National Recognition Awards give us the opportunity, as a country, to formally acknowledge those who built this industry into a pillar of our national economy and cemented the Cayman Islands' standing as a leading international financial centre. Their contribution has shaped opportunity for every Caymanian, and it is only right that we honour that legacy on National Heroes Day."

The Committee brings together individuals from government, districts and the private sector to support the planning and delivery of the awards. Government members include committee chairperson and chief officer in the Ministry of Youth, Sports, Culture and Heritage, Teresa Echenique, along with representatives from the Protocol Office, Department of Communications and the Cayman Islands National Archives.

District representatives include Carl Brown, Lynne Whittaker, Carmilee Pearson, Dan Scott, George McCarthy and Jonathan Tibbetts. The Committee also includes representatives from key financial services entities: Dr. Dax Basdeo, Chief Officer for Ministry of Financial Services and Commerce; Cindy Scotland, Managing Director of the Cayman Islands Monetary Authority; Danielle Hennings, Director of Cayman Finance; and Billy Pennington, President of the Cayman Islands Bankers Association.

In the coming days, the Ministry of Youth, Sports, Culture and Heritage will provide information to the public on the awards, including how members of the public can submit nominations.

Employment reforms happening but some problems are entrenched

What may be the most clear-eyed assessment to date of Cayman’s job market and the performance of the amended employment and immigration laws has come from Hon. Minister for Caymanian Employment, Michael Myles.

While reporting an uptick in job applications by Caymanians and more clarity in the process, Min. Myles has also said that the new system has revealed how the previous structure was systematically abused. According to him, that was to the extent where many Caymanian applicants were denied opportunities, and even Caymanian employees were being frustrated to the point of quitting.

In an interview on Radio Cayman with Orrett ‘OC’ Connor, the Caymanian Employment Minister pledged to double down on his drive to make the system even more transparent and beneficial to Caymanians by prioritising them in the jobs market.

According to Min. Myles, some recruiters, HR (human resources) departments, and even some industry sectors are being blatantly discriminatory, mainly against Caymanians but also against foreign workers.

“My team has pushed extremely hard to ensure that we live our mantra of ‘Caymanians first’ he stated while announcing a third Hello to Hire initiative as a pathway to get more Caymanians into jobs and careers.

GAMING THE SYSTEM

Outlining what his Ministry for Caymanian Employment and the Workforce Opportunities & Residency Cayman(WORK) department have encountered while streamlining the employment and immigration system, Mr Myles described situations of ‘shady employers gaming the system’. He urged Caymanian applicants to submit their applications via the WORC portal in addition to applying to the employers. This, he explained, is to ensure that the government has a record of their application.

“Please apply for the job on the WORC portal,” he urged. “Those resumes stay with that particular job. Another thing is that it’s the only way for us to track. “So if you get very overly ambitious and apply for the job just on the employer’s website, we have no clue that you applied, and the employer can say, ‘Well, I didn’t receive that resume.’”

He also said that employers have a legal obligation to advise WORC of applications they have received outside the WORC portal. “They are obligated under law to advise of any applications that they received from a Caymanian outside the portal. However, Mr Myles said some of whom he described as “shady employees” have not been making that disclosure.

“A lot of shady hiring professionals will not be honest about things like that. In my nine or 10 years of doing employment services and certainly professional development, I have dealt with a lot of this. So the safest thing is to apply for the job on the WORC portal because it’s important that we see that you have an interest in that job.”

DISCRIMINATION

The Minister for Caymanian Employment also lamented examples of a recurring pattern of Caymanians being discriminated against, both in applying for jobs and within the workplace.

“There are Caymanians who submit job applications on the WORC portal, but no Caymanians are hired or interviewed. In some cases, these Caymanians may not make the shortlists designed by the employers. So we’ve seen it. And let me say here, and I’ve said it to our team at WORC. There’s no such thing as work permit renewal. The law states that if a Caymanian is qualified for that job, that employer must hire that Caymanian.”

Elaborating on the issue, Min. Myles spoke of Caymanian job applicants being overlooked for positions in favour of work permit holders, and said that is a form of discrimination.

“What I...our boards...and the department battle with it is discrimination against Caymanians. It’s folks coming into the country as an expat. They simply see opportunity, and they say, “Well, I don’t want this person to work with me. I prefer my friend in Europe to work with me’. So therefore, what they do is frustrate us. And most Caymanians aren’t going to sit down there and be talked down to. So we leave our jobs.”

On that point, Mr Myles appealed to Caymanians already in work not to get frustrated and quit, saying there are other avenues available.

“We cannot walk off of jobs. We cannot be frustrated,” he urged. “We have too many people that are our people walking off jobs and giving these people the right to then hire who they want, and then they can go back to immigration and say, ‘Well, you know, we had a Caymanian that abandoned the job’”

He cited mainly the financial services and hotel sectors, saying that’s where such practices prevail among some employers and recruiters.

“There are two industries that primarily I have seen lots of discrimination, from the lack of advancement for Caymanians to not allowing Caymanians to get through the door: financial services and the hotel sector.” According to Min. Myles, this has been observed across a range of job roles and even affects non-Caymanians.

“It’s not just about Caymanians. I’ve had expats call me. I’ve had people from all over the world that are here working and

are being abused right, left, and center. I cannot get them to make a formal complaint to the HR department because of fear of retaliation...Whether it’s in Nepal or the Philippines or Jamaica or wherever, they are petrified of making that call. But they needed to air it with someone, and someone gave them my number, and I will listen. But I cannot be the complainant.”

REFORMS

According to Minister for Caymanian Employment Myles, there has been a long-standing practice of people trying to game the system, which he said had become a political pinball over the years. However, he affirmed that he is committed to reforming the system with the policies he has put in place.

“They are trying to game the system... Unfortunately, we’ve allowed it across governments for decades. And the chickens have come home to roost with us that our people are being brutalised.” He also said there is a wider cost to society and the government if such practices are allowed to continue.

“When you deny the Caymanian an opportunity, that Caymanian needs to eat; they need to be housed. We are all arguing about the cost of living. Where do you think that money is going to come from to protect those people? It’s going to come from those same employers because the cost of living is going to go up. Why? We have to now send them to the Department of Financial Assistance(DFA) to qualify for that...Well, taxes go up because we need to pay for that. Somebody has to pay for it, right?”

The conversion is intended to:

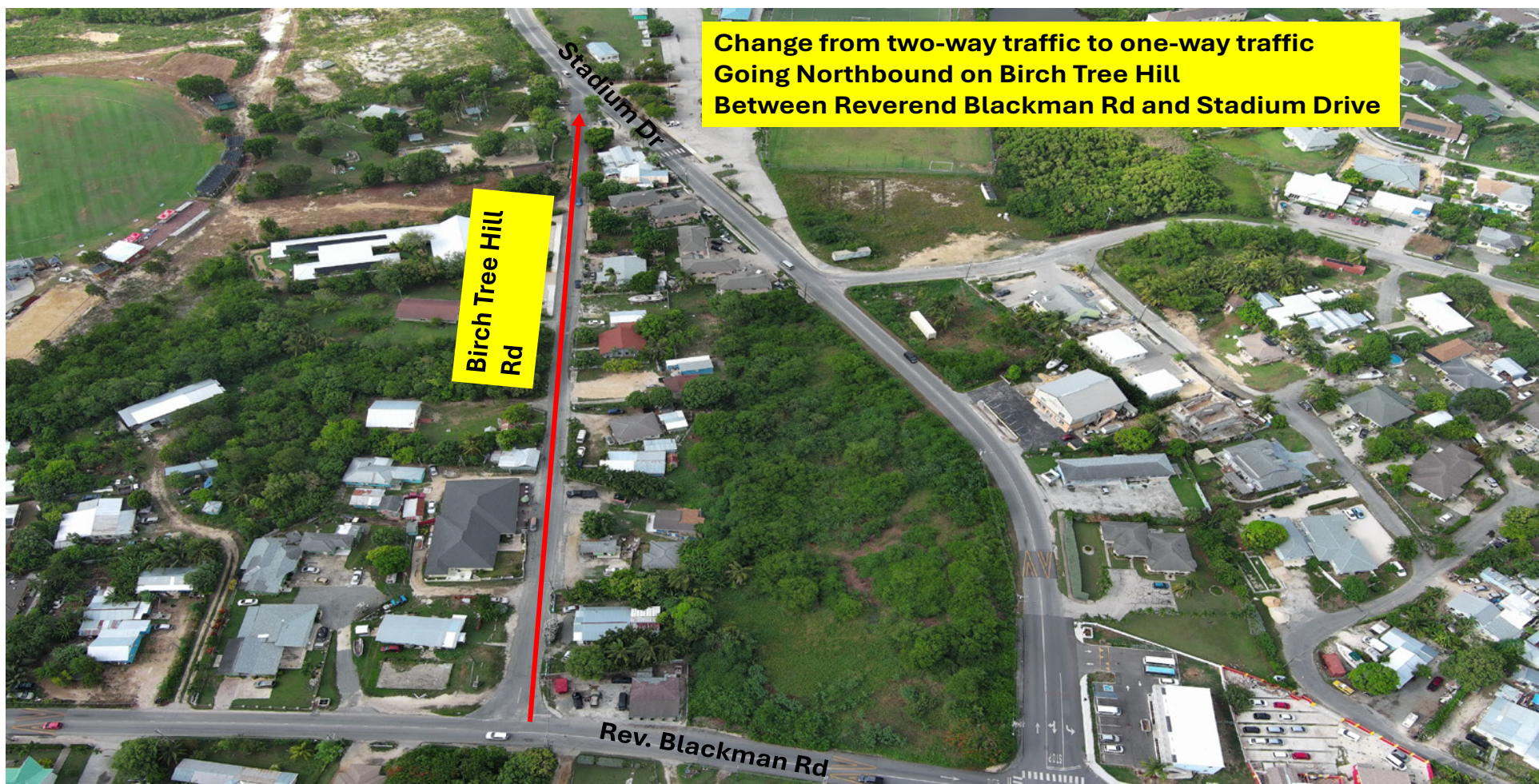
- Improve roadway capacity and traffic flow;

- Support smoother and more efficient movement through the area.

As road users become familiar with the new arrangement, motorists travelling through the area are reminded to:

- Observe all posted road signs;
- Adhere to the posted speed limits; and
- Follow the new one-way northbound traffic configuration.

dren and for exposing them to this wonderful cultural exchange."

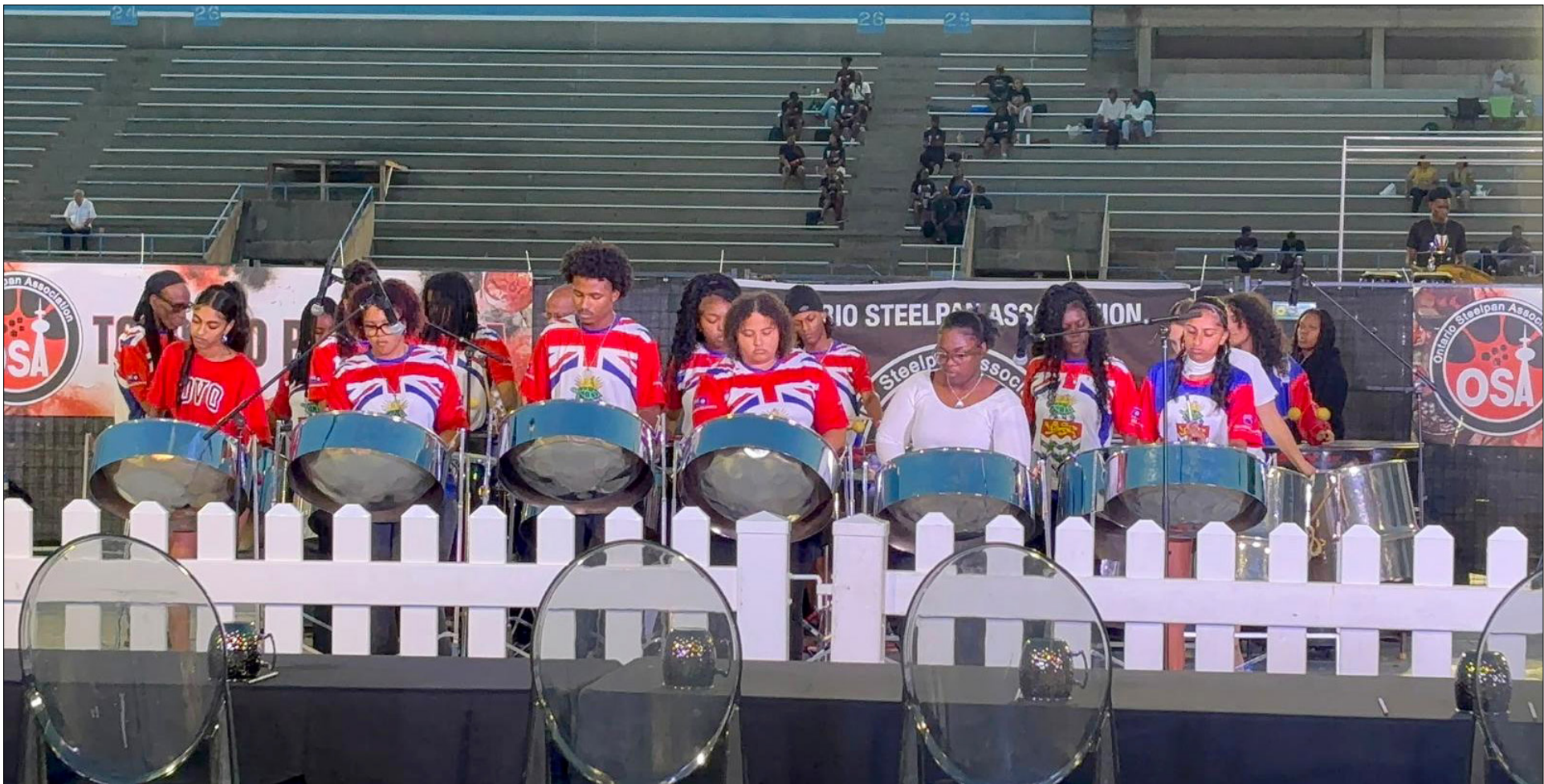

many of the region's top soca and zouk stars.

In the comprehensive document, he addresses issues under the headings of: The Creative Wealth of a People, Education and Cultural Infrastructure, Creative Business Training, Cultural Incubators, Museums and Archives, Recording Studios and Government Grants.

"The Caribbean therefore needs stronger systems for creative business training. Educational institutions, governments, and private organizations should develop programs focused specifically on the economics of culture," he urges.

Montserrat-born Prynze who runs Paran Soundz Global, says artistes must learn how to manage intellectual property, build sustainable brands, negotiate contracts, market digital content, and access international markets.

"Professionalizing the creative sector does not weaken authenticity. It strengthens sustainability."

He also makes the point that if the Caribbean wishes to build sustainable creative economies, then education and cultural infrastructure must become central parts of national development strategies.



"The Caribbean continues to spend millions importing entertainment while

local creatives struggle to secure funding, exposure, and institutional support.



International acts are often prioritized over regional talent for festivals and public events, while local artists are expected to perform for "exposure" rather than fair compensation. This imbalance not only weakens local industries but also reinforces the dangerous belief that foreign value is somehow superior to our own."

At the same time, Prynze says, regional collaboration between Caribbean creatives remains underdeveloped. Islands with shared histories and similar struggles too often operate in isolation rather than partnership.

"Instead of building sustainable creative networks across the region, we compete for limited opportunities while global industries profit from the very culture we underinvest in ourselves."

Premier Advances Insurance Regulatory Engagement with US Stakeholders

Grand Cayman, 20 August 2026 - Premier and Minister for Financial Services and Commerce, the Hon. André M. Ebanks MP, reinforced the Cayman Islands' commitment to strong insurance supervision and international regulatory cooperation during recent engagements with insurance and reinsurance stakeholders in the United States.

At the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) 2026 Summer National Meeting in Columbus, Ohio last week, the Premier led a Cayman Islands delegation that met with state regulators and other international stakeholders. The meetings covered developments in the insurance and reinsurance sectors, cross-border regulatory cooperation and the Cayman Islands' recently submitted application for Qualified Jurisdiction Status (QJS).

The QJS designation recognises jurisdictions whose reinsurance supervisory frameworks meet the NAIC's standards. It would enable eligible Cayman Islands reinsurers to operate in the US market under reduced collateral requirements, subject to applicable regulatory conditions.

Cayman's decision to pursue the designation reflects the continued growth of its commercial reinsurance sector, supported by the country's established financial services infrastructure, professional expertise and longstanding insurance and commercial ties with the United States. With much of Cayman's insurance and reinsur-

ance activity connected to the US market, effective cross-border oversight and continued regulatory cooperation remain important to both jurisdictions.

"At its core, this application is about reinforcing confidence and demonstrating that the Cayman Islands is a country that commissioners can rely on," Premier Ebanks said. "Our discussions allowed us to underscore the Cayman Islands' commitment to effective supervision and international regulatory cooperation. We welcomed the positive engagement and look forward to continued discussions throughout the process, which we understand will take approximately 16 to 18 months."

The QJS application process is a single application submitted in phases. The first phase covers property and casualty insurance, an area in which the Cayman Islands' regulatory framework is already well established. The second phase will cover life and annuity insurance.

As Cayman's commercial reinsurance industry has developed, the Cayman Islands Government and the Cayman Islands Monetary Authority have continued to advance the regulatory regime and build the specialist capabilities required to oversee increasingly complex reinsurance business. Following the submission, Cayman will maintain its engagement with the NAIC and relevant US regulators as the assessment progresses.

"We are focused on ensuring that Cayman's reinsurance industry continues to

develop within a strong and credible regulatory environment," Premier Ebanks said. "A well-regulated reinsurance sector complements our existing, sterling financial services strengths, supports economic growth and, in turn, creates new career opportunities for young Caymanians. Pursuing Qualified Jurisdiction Status will help Cayman continue to mature in this area while demonstrating our commit-

ment to high supervisory standards."

Accompanying the Premier in Ohio were Parliamentary Secretary, Julie Hunter MP; the Ministry's Senior Policy Advisor, Razaak Busari; Cabinet Office International Affairs Analyst, Sean Whewell; and representatives from the Cayman Islands Monetary Authority. Members of the Cayman International Reinsurance Companies Association were also in attendance.

Shields drops weight to regain title

Claessa Shields completed a remarkable journey from heavyweight to middleweight in Georgia on Sunday.

Shields stopped Australia's Kaye Scott in the sixth round to capture the WBA and WBC titles.

The five-division world champion and double Olympic gold medallist dominated her outclassed opponent from the opening bell at State Farm Arena in Atlanta before dropping Scott in the sixth and overwhelming her against the ropes after the action resumed. With Scott unable to defend herself from another sustained barrage, the 42-year-old champion's corner threw in the towel.

The victory improved Shields's professional record to 19-0 with four knockouts while Scott fell to 5-2-1. It also returned the 31-year-old American to championship status at 160lb, a division she had previously ruled as undisputed champion before moving through light-heavyweight and into the heavyweight ranks.

Shields, who remains the undisputed heavyweight champion, had not fought

at middleweight since defeating Maricela Cornejo in June 2023. The anticipated effects of that dramatic weight loss never materialised against Scott, a decorated amateur who entered the paid ranks at 39 as she approached the IBA's upper age limit, yet remained a significant underdog in only her eighth professional bout.

"It was a hard camp," Shields said. "I always tell myself that everything is easy work, but it was a really hard camp. I cut 38 pounds. I started 14 weeks ago at 198 and then I got down to 160. It was the most disciplined I've been since the Olympics, I feel like."

Shields named fellow Olympic champion Lauren Price of Britain as her preferred next opponent at 160lb and said she hoped the fight could be staged in December or January. She also raised the possibility of facing Mikaela Mayer or pursuing undisputed status at middleweight against Canada's Tammara Thibault, who won the IBF, WBO and Ring titles in her fifth professional fight last weekend in Orlando.

Greaves brilliance earns shortlisting for award

Justin Greaves is easily the West Indies most improved player right now which earned him a place among the three nominees for the ICC Men's Player of the Month award for July.

The 32-year-old Barbadian is named with England's Harry Brook and Bangladesh opener Tanzid Hasan after producing a series of match-defining performances for the West Indies across Test and ODI cricket.

Greaves was named Player-of-the-Series in West Indies' 1-0 Test series victory over Sri Lanka and received the same distinction following the drawn two-match Test series against Pakistan.

His nomination comes after a month in which he amassed 215 Test runs at an average of 71.66 and claimed eight wickets at an extraordinary average of 10.25.

Across two Tests, Greaves averaged more than 70 with the bat while conceding just 10.25 runs per wicket with the ball. He also appeared in two ODIs during the month, scoring 32 runs at a strike rate of 114.28.

Mahomes new contract proves Chiefs investing fully in star QB

Kansas City Chiefs quarterback Patrick Mahomes who signed the NFL's first guaranteed \$500m contract, is racing to be fit for the season opener next month.

Mahomes, a three-time Super Bowl winner, recently extended his contract by two years through to 2033 in a deal worth \$504.75m. The entire sum will be guaranteed through contract clauses and 30-year-old Mahomes can earn up

to \$522.25m through incentives - after signing the initial \$477m-guaranteed deal in 2020.

The extension begins in 2027 and is worth \$64 million a year, making it the highest yearly average salary in the NFL and the biggest contract in sports history. Mahomes is now paid over \$170m more guaranteed money than his closest competitor - the \$330m contract of

Buffalo Bills quarterback Josh Allen - as he looks to cement his legacy and take his side to a third Super Bowl victory in eight seasons as a starter.

Mahomes boasts a 95-31 career record and is 17-4 in the playoffs, while averaging the highest passing yards in NFL history at 285.2 per game and winning two NFL MVPs along the way.

The Chiefs, though, had their first losing season with Mahomes at the helm in 2025, as the team were 6-8 before Mahomes suffered an ACL injury in December and missed the last three games of the season - all losses. The Chiefs open their season against the Denver Broncos on September 15 and Mahomes hopes to be lining up.
