IS HARRY HEADING HOME?

In what's playing out like another episode of a gripping drama, the UK is now locked into the latest instalment of the saga surrounding Prince Harry, the youngest son of King Charles III.

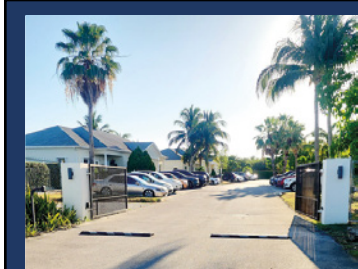
Ever since it was revealed earlier this month that Prince Harry and his family, who now reside in the United States, will be returning to the UK, there has been constant buzz and speculation, sprinkled with a few facts.

When and why they'll be returning to the UK has dominated the media-driven

discourse to date.

Prince Harry and his American wife, Meghan Markle, relocated to the United States in March 2020, following a short stay in Canada, after stepping back from being working members of the British royal family. They were married in the UK in 2018. Their departure came amid a wave of controversy, including reports of rifts with other members of the royal family. At the time of the move, it was re-

Statement on Recent Marine Incident

The Cayman Islands Government is aware of an incident that occurred on Monday 24 August, involving a visitor who sustained an injury while in the water in the vicinity of Governor's Beach.

Immediate action was taken in response to the incident by a multi-agency team consisting of the Department of Environment (DoE) marine unit and the Royal Cayman Islands Police Service (RCIPS) air operations unit, who are working to locate and remove the fish from the area using all available resources.

The individual was transported to the hospital to receive treatment for their injury. Our hearts go out to the visitor, and

we wish her a full and speedy recovery.

While marine life encounters resulting in injury are rare in the Cayman Islands, local authorities encourage beachgoers to remain mindful of their surroundings, while enjoying our vibrant marine environment.

In the interest of public safety, members of the public and visitors are strongly advised to exercise extreme caution when entering the water in the vicinity of the incident while the DoE and RCIPS carry out their targeted response.

Further information will be provided as it becomes available.



Police update on recent burglaries: one man arrested and charged

Police are investigating two recent series of burglary which have taken place in the George Town and North Side districts.

On Friday, 20 August, police arrested one man, age 26, on suspicion of several of the George Town burglaries, which primarily targeted commercial premises. He has since been charged with two counts of burglary and one Damage to Property, and appeared in court on Monday, 24 August where he was remanded in custody and scheduled to reappear on 2 September at 10AM.

He remains under investigation in relation to the other burglaries.

The offenses in North Side have primarily targeted residential premises, and remain under investigation. Police are reminding members of the public to keep residences secured, and avoid leaving doors and windows open or unlocked.

In addition the public is encouraged to take the following precautions:

- * Ensure valuables inside the premises are not visible near windows or in other areas where they can be seen.

- * Exterior lighting, alarms and CCTV systems should be installed where possible.

- * Security cameras, alarms and exterior lighting should be regularly serviced and checked to ensure that they are functioning properly, particularly at commercial premises.

- * Security procedures should be regularly reviewed with employees of commercial premises.

- * Arrangements should be made for unoccupied properties to be checked regularly.

- * Cash should not be left at commercial premises overnight.

- * Valuable equipment should be properly secured when not in use.

Anyone who believes they have wit-

nessed a burglary in progress or noticed any suspicious activity around residential or commercial premises in recent months, is encouraged to contact the nearest police station.

CPCH Summer Internship Program Bridges Classroom Learning and Real-World Insurance Experience

Colina Property Casualty Holdings Ltd (CPCH), the parent company to Indigo and Saxon Insurance, has successfully concluded its Summer Internship Program, a six-week development initiative that gave seven Caymanian and Bahamians practical experience across the insurance and financial services industry.

Running from 6 July to 14 August 2026, the program was built around the theme “A Bridge to Success,” connecting classroom learning with hands-on experience in property and casualty insurance, brokerage, finance, customer service, marketing and operations.

The Cayman cohort included Jelitza Ebanks, Kaylee Jaipaul and Caleb Ebanks, who participated in structured training, department rotations, job shadowing, mentorship, online learning, senior leadership engagement and practical project work.

Interns were introduced to key industry concepts including underwriting, claims, ratemaking, reinsurance, compliance, solvency, risk and capital management, while also developing professional skills in areas such as customer experience, sales, digital marketing, cybersecurity, communication and workplace conduct.

“As part of the program, we wanted the interns to gain exposure beyond the day-to-day workings of the business and to see how the wider insurance industry operates,” said Brian Williams, Co-Founder and CEO of Indigo Insurance.

“Attending reinsurance meetings with our Leadership Team in Miami gave them the opportunity to engage with the industry in a real-world setting and better understand the role reinsurance plays within the insurance sector.”

The program culminated in an Intern Pitch Competition held in The Bahamas on 12 August, where interns presented original concepts addressing emerging customer and insurance needs.

Cayman interns Caleb Ebanks and Jelitza Ebanks travelled to The Bahamas to participate in the competition, with Jelitza progressing to the final alongside Bahamian intern Lakell Clarke.

Jelitza was ultimately named the competition winner for her Climate Relocation Assistance Program, receiving the US\$500 Grand Prize.

Mr Williams said that the “CPCH Summer Internship Program is about giving young people more than an introduction to the workplace; it is about giving them meaningful exposure to the industry, access to experienced leaders and the confidence to develop and present ideas of their own.”

“Seeing the calibre of thinking demonstrated throughout the program, and particularly during the pitch competition, reinforces the importance of creating opportunities that help develop the next generation of professionals across our region,” he added.

The program also provides interns with mentorship, networking opportunities, certification and recognition, stipend and bonus incentives and the potential to return for future internship opportunities.

“It has been rewarding to see how much they have developed over the six weeks, and we are already looking forward to welcoming the next group of young people for the CPCH Summer Internship Program in 2027,” said Mr Williams.

Healthcare stakeholders contribute to shaping Cayman Islands health legislation

The future of healthcare legislation in the Cayman Islands is being shaped through collaboration between Government and the healthcare professionals who deliver care to the community.

That was the message from a recent Healthcare Stakeholder Consultation hosted by the Ministry of Health, Environment and Sustainability, where healthcare practitioners and other sector stakeholders came together learn about the four proposed Bills and provide direct feedback on the reforms.

Held at the Grand Cayman Marriott Resort, the consultation focused on the proposed Public Health Bill, 2026; Environmental Health Bill, 2026; Tobacco (Amendment) Bill, 2026; and Health Practice (Amendment) Bill, 2026. The engagement was designed to go beyond presenting the proposed legislation. Healthcare professionals were invited to ask questions, identify areas for consideration and share their practical experience of working within the health system. Participants submitted questions and suggestions in real time through a QR code before taking part in an open discussion with Ministry representatives.

For one participating healthcare professional, the opportunity to contribute directly to public policy was particularly significant. "Back home I never had the opportunity to participate in something like this, where frontline healthcare professionals are invited to contribute directly to the development of public policy," the participant said.

The experience highlighted the value of creating opportunities for those working directly with patients and communities to have a voice in the systems that govern healthcare.

The Minister for Health, Environment and Sustainability, Hon. Katherine Ebanks-Wilks, said the Government has a responsibility to listen as it develops legislation that will affect the health and wellbeing of the country.

"Good legislation is not developed in isolation. It is strengthened by the experience, expertise and practical knowledge of the people who will work with it every

day," Minister Ebanks-Wilks said.

"Many of you have dedicated your careers to caring for our community. You understand the realities of delivering healthcare, protecting public health, regulating professional standards and responding to the changing needs of our population. Your perspective is invaluable."

Minister Ebanks-Wilks said the reforms represent an opportunity to bring the legislative framework in line with the Cayman Islands' current needs.

"Our population has grown, healthcare has advanced, new public health challenges have emerged and our expectations of the systems that protect our communities have evolved. Our legislative framework must evolve as well," she said.

The Chief Officer for the Ministry of Health, Environment and Sustainability, Ms. Tamara Ebanks, said the expertise of healthcare stakeholders is an essential part of developing legislation that can work effectively in practice.

"While each Bill focuses on a different aspect of health and wellbeing, they share a common purpose: to modernise legislation so that it reflects the realities of a growing and evolving country," Ms. Ebanks said. "Healthcare professionals and stakeholders bring valuable expertise and practical experience that can help us ensure these Bills are effective, workable and responsive to the needs of our community."

The consultation is part of the Ministry's broader engagement on the proposed legislative package. The Ministry is continuing to invite feedback as the Bills progress through the consultation process. Public consultation is currently open on the Tobacco (Amendment) Bill, 2026 and the Health Practice (Amendment) Bill, 2026.

The Public Health Bill, 2026 and Environmental Health Bill, 2026 are intended to be published for public review on 28 August. The new publication date will allow for further consideration of stakeholder feedback and the inclusion of relevant suggestions where appropriate, helping to strengthen the Bills. Members of the public are encouraged to review the proposed legislation and submit their feedback through publicconsultation.gov.ky and mohfeedback@gov.ky

Minister Ebanks-Wilks said the purpose of the engagement is to build stronger legislation through an open exchange of knowledge and experience.

"Today's discussion is not simply about legislation; it is about partnership," she said. "If there are ways these proposals can be improved, we want to hear them. That is the purpose of consultation, and it is how we develop stronger policy and better outcomes for our country."

The Ministry encourages healthcare professionals, members of the public and other stakeholders to participate in the consultation process and help shape legislation that will form part of the Cayman Islands' health framework for years to come.

Cayman Islands court opens new path through strata deadlock in landmark ruling

In a novel ruling, the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands has held that unbuilt strata buildings can be treated as ‘destroyed’ for the purpose of removing them from a strata plan. The decision provides what appears to be the first practical solution to a longstanding statutory deadlock where unanimous consent to alter a strata plan cannot be obtained.

Brett Basdeo, Insolvency and Dispute Resolution Partner, commented:

‘Can you legally ‘destroy’ a strata building that was never built? The Grand Court of the Cayman Islands has answered that question with a resounding yes, in perhaps the first decision of its kind in any common law jurisdiction.

Phased strata developments can stall for many reasons including financial difficulties, changes in planning policy or the death of the original developer. When that happens, traditionally undeveloped land becomes trapped within the strata scheme. The legislation requires unanimous consent to amend the development plan and, if even one interested party fails to respond, the land can effectively be fro-

zen indefinitely. This judgment provides the first practical mechanism out of that deadlock while protecting the rights of ex-

isting owners.

The significance of the decision lies in the court’s willingness to interpret ‘de-

struction’ as a legal concept rather than a purely physical one. That approach allowed the court to solve a problem that the legislation did not expressly contemplate and unlock land that had been trapped within an incomplete development for more than a decade.

Given the prevalence of strata and condominium developments across common law jurisdictions, including the UK, Australia and Canada, the court’s reasoning is likely to attract close attention wherever similar disputes arise.

A few key takeaways also include:

- In a novel ruling, the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands has deemed unbuilt strata buildings could be deemed ‘destroyed’ in order to remove them from strata plans.

- The ruling offers the first practical route through statutory deadlock where unanimous consent for the alteration of the strata plan cannot be secured.

- The decision may be the first of its kind in common law jurisdictions and may influence strata and condominium disputes across other jurisdictions.

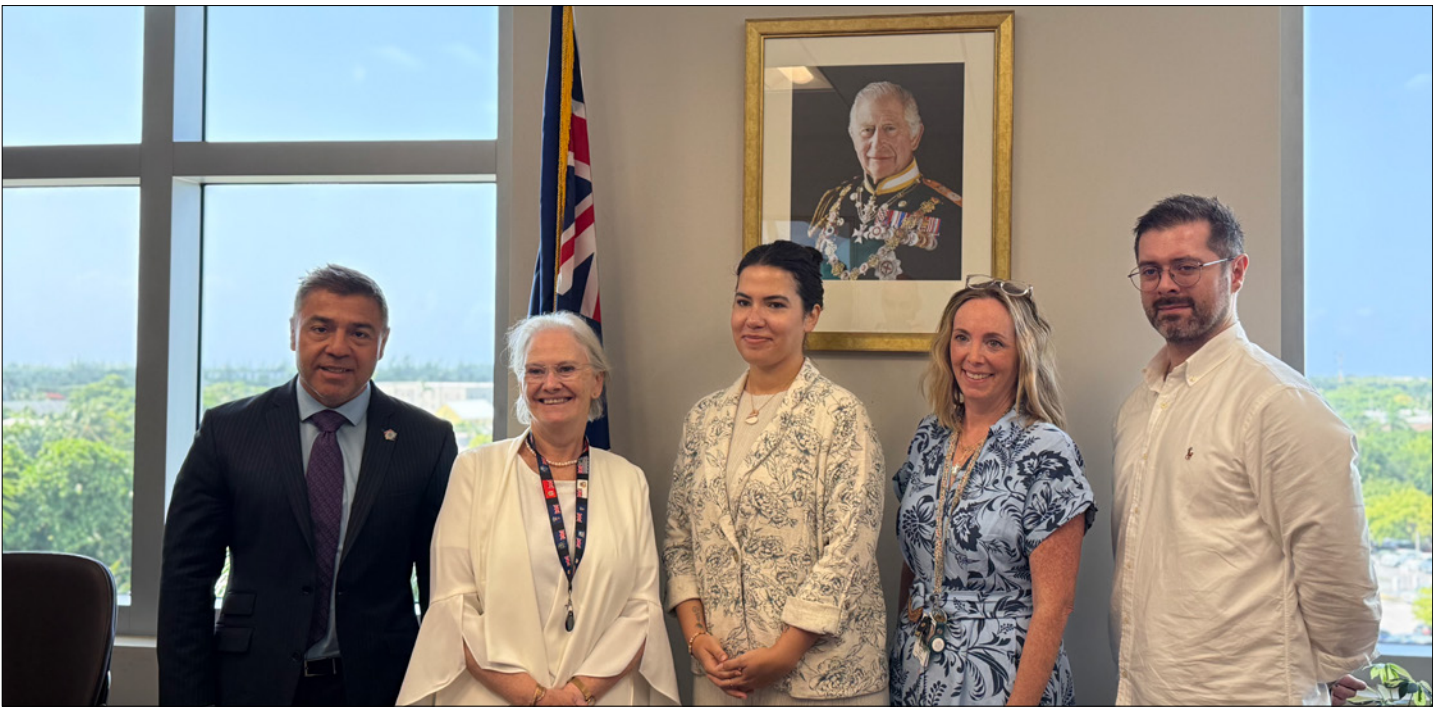


New LGBTQ Non-Profit OURS Cayman Meets with HE Governor

ported that their decision was also driven by the need for privacy to escape unrelenting media scrutiny. Some coverage has ended up in high-profile court cases. Financial independence and issues of security were also said to have been factors for their move. They also withdrew from royal duties. The couple no longer carry the title of His or Her Royal Highness (HRH), and Prince Harry has also given up his military titles, although he remains close to the British military as an ex-soldier, running support programs for ex-soldiers, including the highly regarded Invictus Games. Prince Harry remains fifth in line to the throne. His wife Meghan, a former actress, has been involved in a series of media projects and is reported to be earmarked for a major upcoming movie project in the UK.

Their two American-born children are formally known as Prince Archie and Princess Lilibet of Sussex after King Charles, their grandfather, ascended to the throne

following the death of Queen Elizabeth II in 2022.

Just over a year ago, Prince Harry had told the British Broadcasting Corporation(BBC): “I can’t see a world in which I would bring my wife and children back to the UK at this point.”

The BBC has now reported that ‘since news broke of the move, there has been some confusion as to what British life for Harry and Meghan will look like’. But it claims that a picture is emerging of the family’s priorities. It said the couple will be back in the UK about a week before the autumn school term begins for their two children, seven-year-old Archie and five-year-old Lilibet. At the same time though, other press reports suggest that a return might be short-term.

Some media outlets have linked Prince Harry’s return to the UK as ‘the prodigal son returning home’, and also to the health of his father, King Charles III. The 77-year-old King has made it public that he has undergone treatment for cancer and has been living with the condition.

What is the menopause?

The British Dietetics Association states that menopause occurs 12 months after the last menstrual period, at which point a woman becomes postmenopausal. Symptoms of perimenopause typically occurs between 45-55 years with the average age of the menopause being 51 years.

During menopause, the decline in oestrogen levels is associated with an increased risk of several chronic diseases, including cardiovascular disease, certain cancers, type 2 diabetes and osteoporosis.

What are the most common symptoms of menopause?

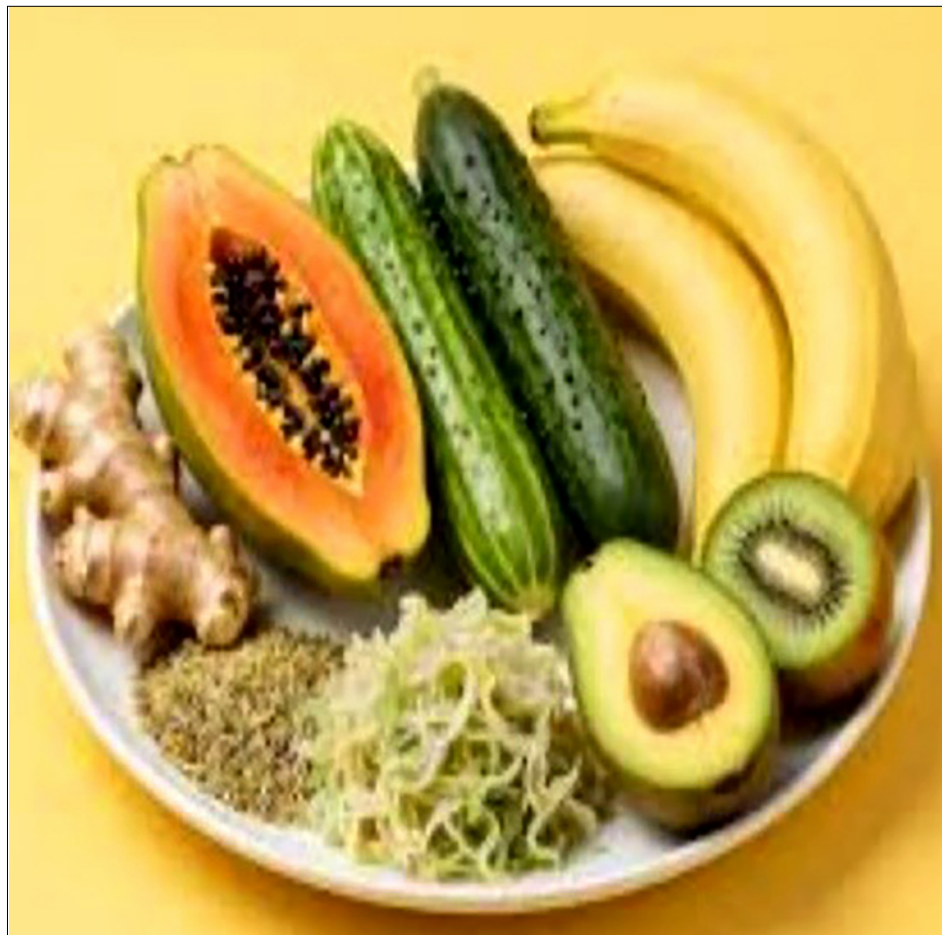
The British Menopause Society (BMS) asserts that women experience menopause differently, with some having few or no symptoms. The most common symptoms are hot flushes and night sweats (vasomotor symptoms), insomnia, low energy levels, impaired memory, headaches, brain fog, joint aches and weight gain.

Nutrition

Nutrition has emerged as a cornerstone of menopausal health management. As oestrogen levels decline, a healthy, balanced diet can help support women through menopause by providing essential nutrients for bone, heart and overall health.

Gut health

Improving your gut health means focusing on eating a diverse range of colourful plant-based foods to improve gut health and reduce inflammation. Professor Tim Spector, a prominent UK based genetic epidemiologist and expert in gut microbiome, is a leading advocate for the 'eat the rainbow' approach and consuming at least



30 plants a week.

Eating 30 plants a week can sound daunting, but is achievable and includes fruits, vegetables, wholegrains, beans, lentils, nuts, seeds, herbs and spices. Additionally, fermented foods are powerhouses for gut health. Diverse plants provide different fibres and polyphenols which help to nourish different species in the gut microbiome.

Heart health

Declining oestrogen levels can affect heart health, making it important to choose foods that support healthy cholesterol and blood pressure. Eat a diet rich in a variety of fruits, vegetables, wholegrains, beans, lentils, nuts, seeds, oily fish while limiting foods high in saturated fats, salt and sugar.

Bone health

During menopause, getting enough protein, calcium and vitamin D is important, because falling oestrogen levels can re-

duce bone density, increasing the risk of osteoporosis and fractures. Include sources of calcium such as milk, yoghurt, dark green leafy vegetables and fortified foods. Vitamin D sources include sunlight on the skin, oily fish, eggs and fortified breakfast cereals. Protein sources include poultry, soya products, nuts and seeds.

Plant Oestrogens

Plant oestrogens (isoflavones) are substances in plants that are similar to human oestrogen and found in soya beans, edamame, tofu, miso, tempeh and chickpeas and may help ease menopausal signs.

Fibre-rich foods

Fibre is essential during menopause as it supports healthy digestion, heart health and blood sugar control. In the UK, The National Health Service (NHS) recommends 30g of fibre per day for adults.

Increase your fibre intake gradually, especially if you haven't eaten much fibre before, as doubling would likely lead to bloating, wind and discomfort because the

gut microbiome hasn't had time to adapt. Here are some fibre and nutrient dense foods I usually add to my weekly shopping basket: avocados, oats, beans, lentils, chickpeas, sweet potatoes, apples, berries, walnuts, citrus fruits, chia seeds and flax seeds.

Stay hydrated

Staying hydrated during menopause is vital, as hormonal changes can contribute to symptoms such as hot flushes and sweating, increasing the need to replace lost fluids. So keep a water bottle with you and drink regularly.

Reduce consumption of trigger foods.

Cut down on foods that make your symptoms worsen. The British Nutrition Foundation notes that spicy foods, caffeine and alcohol can trigger or worsen night sweats and hot flushes in some women during menopause.

Lifestyle factors

Physical activity and menopause: Exercise helps to maintain muscle strength, support bone health and improve heart health. Aim to reduce long periods of sitting.

Sleep and menopause: Sleep difficulties are more likely to occur during menopause. Deviating from the recommended 7 to 8 hours of sleep in adults is associated with a higher risk of cardiovascular disease. Getting enough good quality sleep during menopause is vital for energy, mood and overall wellbeing.

Stress management: Engage in regular exercise, relaxation techniques, adequate sleep and activities to support your wellbeing.
