This category will recognise up to 25 individuals who led or contributed to the establishment of the Cayman Islands as an international financial centre before 2000 and whose contributions have left a lasting impact within the industry.

Innovators of the Industry ("Pioneers")

Up to 75 individuals may be recognised in this category for long-term and transformative contributions to the development of the Cayman Islands' financial services industry. Eligible nominees should have contributed 30 years or more in either the public or private sectors.

Builders of the Industry (Group Award)

This category will recognise up to 30 organisations that have operated in the Cayman Islands for 30 years or more and made exceptional, long-standing contributions to the financial services industry and the wider development of the Islands.

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UCCI STEM Camp celebrates 10 years of hands-on learning

The University College of the Cayman Islands (UCCI) marked a proud milestone this summer as its STEM Summer Camp celebrated its tenth anniversary — a decade of hands-on exploration, scientific curiosity, and growing confidence among Cayman's young innovators. Acting President Dr. J.D. Livingston congratulated students and families at the

closing ceremony, noting that the camp has become one of UCCI's most impactful youth programmes.

A Week of Real Discovery

Over five lively days, students aged 10 to 13 immersed themselves in robotics, renewable energy experiments, environmental science, 3D printing, and physics

demonstrations. The camp's emphasis on doing rather than just listening was evident everywhere — from buzzing worktables to the excited chatter of students comparing their creations.

For 10-year-old Luke Blackwood of Joanna Clarke Primary School, the stand-out project was a solar-powered car he assembled with quiet confidence.

"It's a little car. It's powered by solar energy with the solar panel on top," he explained, holding up the foldable three panel design. "It's meant to resemble a Mars Rover and it has these wheels which are connected to the motor. It will only work in the sunlight."

Luke said it took him "ten to fifteen minutes" to build — "It's not really that hard," he added with a grin.

But like many campers, Luke's biggest thrill came from the liquid nitrogen demonstration.

"I learned that its temperature is minus 200 degrees," he said. "When it touches things, they freeze instantly — like magic."

Behind the Scenes: Resilience and Good Humour

One of the camp's lead organisers welcomed families with warmth — and a touch of honesty about the final morning's chaos.

"Today we had all the frustrations for the whole week in one morning," she said. "All our drones stopped working... every single one of them."

The room laughed, but the message was clear: STEM isn't just about success — it's about problem solving, adapting, and carrying on.

This year's programme also introduced new elements, including a Spirit Award for the camper who showed the most enthusiasm, and a Vlog Competition for students who documented the camp through photos and videos. Two academic prizes were awarded for Physics and Maths, with a playful drum roll moment as desks rattled across the room.

"First prize for Physics and Math... goes to Victor Elliott!" she announced, to cheers.

He reflected on how attitudes toward STEM careers have shifted over the past decade.

"Hopefully this room is now getting the message, to both kids and parents, that STEM and STEM careers are now a very significant part of the opportunities that are available locally in Cayman," he said. "This is a well established sector, and hopefully, if you parents have a child that is interested in STEM, I hope that you feel

a level of comfort you might not have felt ten years ago."

He encouraged families to keep the momentum going.

"There are other STEM-type activities available. Seek them out, and continue to learn and continue to grow."

Kirkconnell also expressed appreciation for the partnership: "I'd like to say thank you to UCCI for having us continue ten years as a sponsor."

Other supporters, including the Cayman Water Authority, played practical roles — such as keeping campers hydrated with donated water bottles.

Celebrating the Campers

Among this year's award recipients was Naomi Tobutt (12), who earned the Camper of the Week (female) award.

She said she was "very pleased" to be chosen and highlighted two favourites: the liquid nitrogen demonstration and building a terrarium — a miniature ecosystem of gravel, soil, and plants designed to show how larger natural systems function.

Her counterpart, Adaayan Agarwal (13), received the Camper of the Week (male) award along with several top prizes. He said he had "learned a lot from the camp" and "enjoyed it very much," especially the

hands-on challenges.

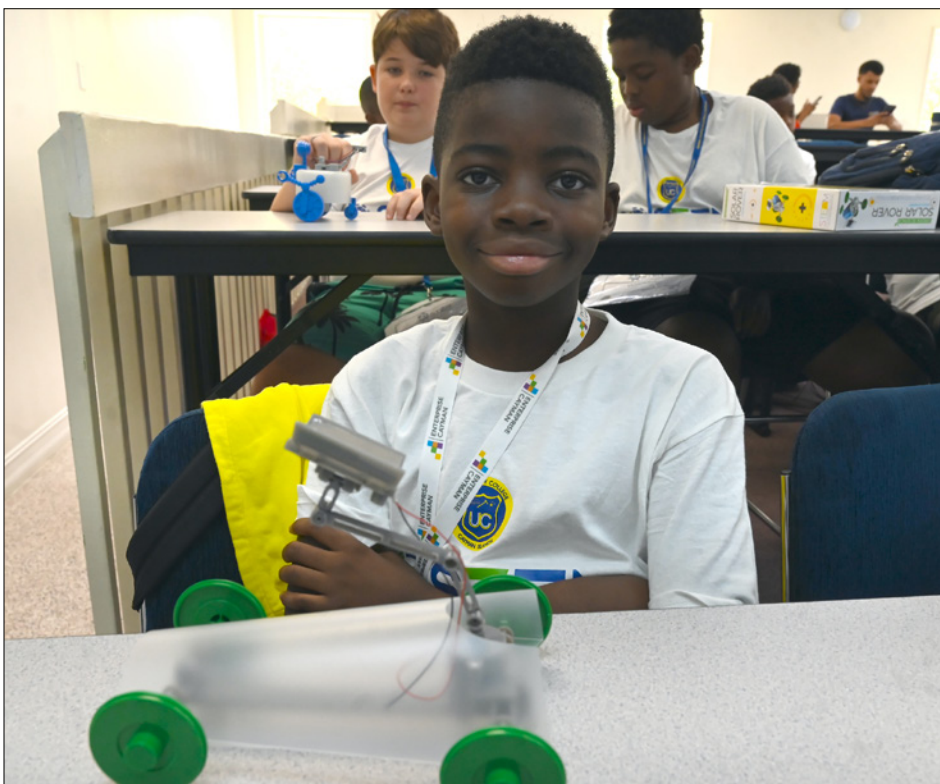
Thinking Like Scientists

As certificates were handed out and families gathered for photos, one camper summed up the spirit of the week:

"I didn't just learn about science — I learned how to think like a scientist."

With ten years now behind it, UCCI's STEM Summer Camp continues to grow in ambition and impact. It remains one of Cayman's most vibrant youth programmes — a place where curiosity is encouraged, confidence is built, and the next generation of problem solvers begins to take shape.

Commitment to turn ‘Hello2Hired’ turnout into jobs

Hon. Minister for Caymanian Employment and Immigration, Michael Myles, said the improved turnout demonstrated the value of creating accessible opportunities for Caymanians and employers to connect directly.

“This event is about giving Caymanians the opportunity to get in front of employers, have meaningful conversations and better understand the opportunities available to them and what employers are looking for,” Minister Myles said. “Just as importantly, jobseekers can access practical support to strengthen how they present themselves and approach the recruitment process. We want Caymanians to leave these events better informed, better prepared and with stronger connections

to employment opportunities.”

MAKING CONNECTIONS

Speaking with the Caymanian Times newspaper, Min. Myles explained: “This is about connecting Caymanians to employment. When we looked at establishing the Hello 2 Hired programme, it was about ensuring that employers came with jobs rather than marketing materials.”

Mr Myles also said that too often, people attend recruitment drives only to leave without any meaningful prospects. What we’ve tried to do differently is ensure that if an employer is here, they actually have vacancies. We’ve coupled that with our database of specifically unemployed people. I’m interested in getting people jobs.”

The Minister for Caymanian Employment also stated: “I am not naive enough

to think that every Caymanian wants a job, but for those who do, there should be no reason they cannot find one.”

Noting that the Cayman Islands has more than 37,000 work-permit holders, meaning there are more jobs than eligible Caymanians, he added: “The goal now is to make those opportunities more accessible.

You bring employers into a space where all they have to offer is employment.”

Mr Myles said the jobs fair and the interview skills workshop were held simultaneously because many young people do not fully understand the range of opportunities available.

tunities available within particular industries.

Hospitality, for example, extends far beyond housekeeping and food service. The industry also offers positions in human resources, information technology, management and supervision—areas many job seekers may not immediately associate with the sector.

“We have to move on from that. Caymanians are coming into entry-level roles and staying there. Where is the training and retraining? We need to have people climbing the employment ladder,” he said.

MAKING JOBS ‘FAIR’

Mr Myles said he regularly receives calls, emails and text messages from Caymanians reporting discrimination across a range of industries.

“The situation is that the people in middle management are not Caymanians, and there is a tendency towards bias. We are feeling the pinch, and the message is that ‘we are not wanted here.’ If you do get in, the person above you may behave in a way that becomes discriminatory.”

He also explained how organisers hoped each interaction between job seekers and employers would unfold.

“We want real interaction where people understand what the job is,” he said. “Can I see you again? Let’s set up an interview. Here is my résumé. I truly want to work here. I’d like to be part of this company. Can we arrange another interview next week?”

FROM ‘HELLO’ TO ‘HIRED’

Min. Myles feels more recruitment events should follow the Hello-2-Hired model, with participating organisations bringing genuine employment opportunities.

“There is too much talking. We have to hire,” he said.

Mr Myles noted that the Ministry had worked with the new Grand Hyatt development to hire more than 100 Cay-

manians for the approximately 500 jobs expected to become available. He added that employing Caymanians also allows companies to save substantial amounts in work-permit fees.

However, the Minister cautioned that Caymanian job seekers must also do their part.

“We have to be more organised, dress appropriately and come prepared. If I know I am coming into a place with 10 or 15 companies, I am coming decked out. You have to dress for success,” he said.

“The moment an employer looks across the room, they should know you are here to get a job.”

Mr Myles said Caymanians must take the opportunities being created seriously, stressing that employment is critical to the country’s long-term success.

If Cayman is unable to move more of its people into gainful employment, he warned, the country could face growing welfare costs and eventually be forced to consider some form of taxation.

“Whatever we are earning in work-per-

mit revenue, we are already having to spend that money to look after people who have no pension or life insurance and are unable to thrive in their later years because they have never had gainful employment,” he said.

Meanwhile, endorsing the Hello2Hired concept, Hon. Premier André Ebanks stated: “Events like Hello2Hired show what’s possible when government and employers work toward the same goal. The NCFC government is committed to making sure Caymanians have clear, genuine pathways into job opportunities, and Hello2Hired is exactly the kind of accessible, results-driven initiative we want to keep building on.”

PUTTING THE PLAN TO ACTION

A government statement said Hello2Hired forms part of MCEI’s wider efforts, supported by Workforce Opportunities and Residency Cayman (WORC), to strengthen employment pathways for Caymanians and improve connections between local talent and employers. The

August event marked the second Hello2Hired recruitment event, following the inaugural event in February 2026, which brought together 66 Caymanian jobseekers and 20 employers.

MCEI and WORC say they will continue to build on Hello2Hired and other employment-focused initiatives aimed at helping Caymanians access opportunities, develop their employability and engage directly with the local labour market.

The August event also placed an increased focus on preparing jobseekers for the recruitment process. Representatives from the Cayman Islands Recruitment Association (CIRA) and the Cayman Islands Tourism Association (CITA) provided one-on-one guidance in career coaching, interview preparation and résumé writing. Workforce Opportunities and Residency Cayman’s (WORC) Employment Services Unit and Labour Market Demand Unit also engaged with employers to strengthen connections, support future Caymanian placements and gain insight into upcoming workforce needs and business growth plans.

DEH Relaunches Recycling Programme in Cayman Brac

Grand Cayman, August 28, 2026 – The Department of Environmental Health (DEH) has relaunched its recycling programme in Cayman Brac, giving residents greater access to recycling services and providing additional opportunities to reduce the amount of waste sent to the landfill.

The relaunch was marked by a visit to Cayman Brac by Minister of Health, Environment and Sustainability, Honourable Katherine Ebanks-Wilks, Minister for District Administration and Home Affairs, Honourable Nickolas DaCosta, and DEH Director Mr. Richard Simms and his team, highlighting the importance of recycling and responsible waste management in the Sister Islands.

The programme has begun with the collection of two recyclable materials streams: Plastic Types 1 (PET) and 2 (HDPE), as well as metal cans and aluminium.

Cayman Brac residents are encouraged to ensure their recyclables are clean before dropping them off at either of the two DEH Recycling Depot locations:

Stake Bay - Outside Layman Scott High School

West End - Outside West End Primary School

The Ministers' presence at the relaunch underscores the Government's commitment to strengthening recycling and waste reduction initiatives throughout the Cayman Islands. Hon. Katherine Ebanks-Wilks, said: "I am delighted to see the recycling programme relaunched on Cayman Brac. One of this government's key initiatives is to develop and implement recycling initiatives as part of its broader waste management strategy. The relaunch of the programme now makes it easier for residents on the Brac to contribute to national efforts to reuse and recycle more, and reduce the

amount of waste ending up in our landfill site. I want to commend Director Simms and his Cayman Brac team for their dedication, professionalism and commitment to providing the residents of Cayman Brac with these new recycling collection depots and for encouraging all of us to think differently about waste."

Hon. Nickolas DaCosta, Minister for District Administration and Home Affairs, added: "This is excellent news for the people of Cayman Brac and another positive step for our community. Residents of the Sister Islands should have meaningful access to the same important environmental services and opportunities available elsewhere in the Cayman Islands, and these conveniently located collection points make recycling more practical and accessible. I look forward to seeing the programme expand with additional locations and recyclable materials, as well as to Little Cayman, and I encourage residents to make full use of the service and help reduce the amount of waste going into our landfill."

DEH Director, Mr. Richard Simms said the relaunch represents an important step in making recycling more accessible to residents of Cayman Brac. "Recycling is a shared responsibility, and we want to make it as convenient as possible for residents to participate. By relaunched the programme in Cayman Brac and providing accessible collection points, we are giving residents another practical way to reduce the amount of waste going into the landfill. We encourage everyone to make recycling part of their everyday routine and to help us build a cleaner and more sustainable Cayman Islands."

Recyclables collected through the programme will be taken to a designated area at the Cayman Brac Landfill, where they will be securely stored until they are shipped to the DEH Recycling Centre in



George Town for processing.

The programme will be expanded in phases, with additional recycling locations and more recyclable material streams coming soon. The DEH also plans to extend the programme to Little Cayman, further increasing recycling opportunities across the Sister Islands.

Recycling provides a range of environmental benefits, including reducing the

volume of waste sent to landfills, conserving natural resources, reducing pollution and supporting the recovery and reuse of valuable materials. Increased recycling can also help extend the operational life of landfill facilities by reducing the amount of material requiring disposal.

Ms Tamara Ebanks, Chief Officer for the Ministry of Health, Environment and Sustainability added her support, reaffirming the initiative's synergy with the Ministry's priorities: "The return of recycling services to Cayman Brac is a welcome step forward and supports the Ministry's broader vision for improving environmental health across the Cayman Islands. As part of our public consultation on the Environmental Health Bill, we have heard strong support from residents in Cayman Brac and Little Cayman for greater access to recycling, with similar views expressed during our engagement in Grand Cayman."

"While we continue to seek the public's feedback on the proposed legislation, initiatives such as this demonstrate the practical steps we can take alongside legislative reform to support cleaner, healthier communities. We hope residents and businesses will make full use of the service, embrace recycling as part of their everyday habits and help reduce the amount of plastic and other recyclable waste entering our waste stream."

The DEH is asking residents to help make the programme successful by recycling responsibly and placing only accepted materials in the designated bins available at the depots. Keeping recyclables clean and separated helps maintain the quality of the materials collected and supports efficient processing.

RCIPS Urges Motorists Caution as Schools Reopen: Focus on Distracted Driving and School Zone Safety

The RCIPS is reminding all motorists to exercise heightened caution and eliminate distractions behind the wheel as children across the Cayman Islands have returned to school. With increased pedestrian and motoring traffic around school zones, including school buses resuming their routes, distracted driving presents a critical risk to young pedestrians and fellow road users.

So far in 2026, the Cayman Islands has recorded an average of 70 motor vehicle collisions per week. Additionally, over 200 drivers have been prosecuted for mobile phone offences, highlighting the persistent prevalence of dangerous driving behaviours.

With students returning to the classroom, motorists must be especially vigilant around designated school zones and stopping school buses. Children can be unpredictable, and driver reaction time is paramount when navigating school drop-off and pick-up areas.

While collisions occur for a variety of reasons, distracted driving, particularly mobile phone usage, remains a suspected contributing factor in many incidents. Drivers who make calls, send text messages, or browse social media significantly reduce their ability to react to sudden hazards, such as children and school buses.

"With the new school year starting, road safety is entirely dependent on driver responsibility," says Chief Inspector Dame-nian Maxwell in charge of the Traffic &



Roads Policing Unit. "A single second looking down at a mobile phone can result in a life-altering tragedy. We are urging all drivers to drop the distractions, slow down in school zones, and respect stopped school buses. No notification is worth risking a child's life."

Motorists are reminded that using a mobile phone while operating a vehicle is an offence under the Traffic Act. Holding a device to call, text, or browse carries an

automatic \$150 fine, with further prosecution applicable if distraction results in a collision. Additionally, school zones will be reactivated and speeding in a school zone during activation periods carries a fine of \$40 per mile over the 15MPH speed limit. If you have surpassed double the speed limit, then you will be warned for intended prosecution, and may face a disqualification of your driver's licence for this offence.

The RCIPS will continue to deploy officers around school zones, bus stops, and high-traffic corridors to ensure motorists obey speed limits, stop for school buses in both directions, and remain off their mobile devices.

The message is clear: Protect our children as they head back to school. Put the phone away, respect school zones, and keep your full attention on the road.

Public Advisory: SMS and Google Meet Phishing Scams Continue to Circulate

The Police are advising the public of a new wave of the ongoing Google Meet call scams involving suspects contacting the public and claiming to be members of local law enforcement, requesting personal and financial details, as well as a new wave of the Post Office Parcel SMS Scam.

In the latest tactic of the Google Meet scam, the suspects are contacting members of the public via audio-only call, purporting to be representatives from local financial institutions, and requesting banking details.

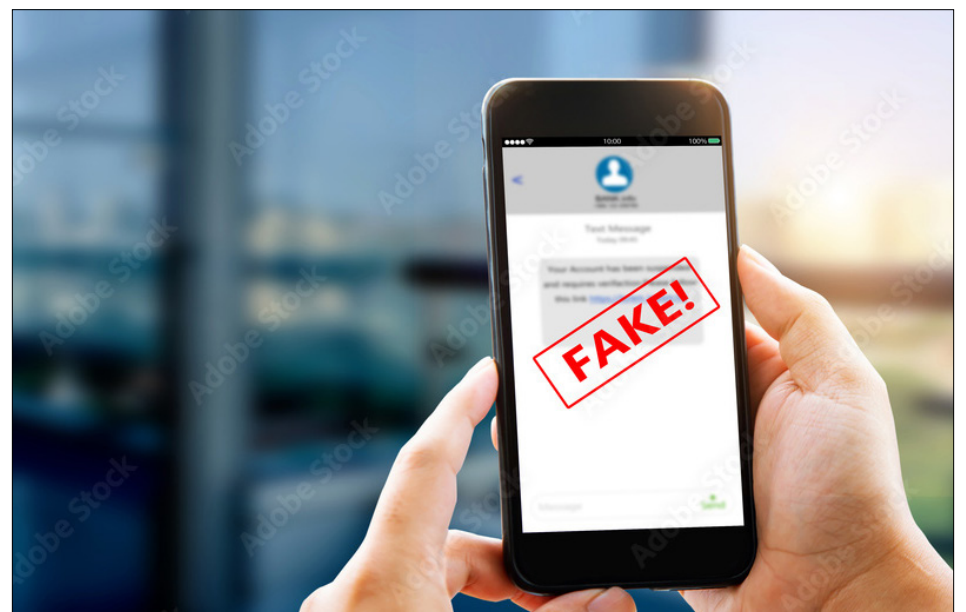
The Post Office Parcel SMS scam continues to involve text messages purporting to be from the Cayman Islands Postal Service, alerting the user of an outstanding parcel, and instructing recipients to click on a fraudulent link to pay for delivery fees. Clicking on the link can result

in your financial information being compromised.

These scams remain active, with different institutions being impersonated via text messages and calls. Varying domain addresses are being included in the text messages.

The RCIPS is reminding members of the public to ignore these messages and contact their financial institutions directly to verify the legitimacy of any communication received by phone or online which involves requests for personal or financial information.

Anyone who believes they may have mistakenly clicked on a link in a similar text message, or provided personal details via phone call, is advised to contact their financial institution immediately and report the matter to the police at 949-4222.



Police Respond to Two-Vehicle Collision in Red Bay

Shortly before 7:15AM Thursday, 27 August, police and other emergency services responded to a two-vehicle collision involving a motorcycle and a motor car in the vicinity of Hurley Merren Boulevard.

It is reported that the motor car had a collision with a motorcycle travelling west along Hurley Merren Boulevard in the vicinity of the Red Bay roundabout. The mo-

torcycle sustained extensive damage, while the motor car sustained major damage.

A third vehicle, travelling eastbound in the opposite lane, also sustained minor damage during the collision, and no injuries were reported.

The driver of the motor car involved in the collision and the rider of the motorcycle were medically assessed at the

scene. The rider was subsequently transported to the Anthony S. Eden Hospital for treatment of what are believed to be non-life-threatening injuries. He remains in stable condition.

Both the motorcycle rider and the driver of the motor car were breath tested, and both returned negative results.

The rider was subsequently arrested

on suspicion of driving while disqualified and remains in police custody.

A police cordon that was put in place while officers processed the scene has since been lifted. Hurley Merren Boulevard was reopened thereafter to vehicular and pedestrian traffic.

The collision remains under investigation by the Traffic & Roads Policing Unit

US and Venezuela strike oil deal

The United States and the Venezuelan governments have confirmed that they have reached an agreement for the US to control around a fifth of Venezuela's oil reserves.

According to various media reports backed by statements attributed to top US and Venezuelan government officials, the US will have access to around 65 billion barrels of Venezuelan oil. It has been described as the US having "a direct stake in more than a dozen oilfields."

In typical triumphalist tones, the US President Donald Trump wrote on his Truth Social social media site that "The United States of America has just entered into an Agreement with the Country of Venezuela." In capital letters, he called it "THE BIGGEST OIL DEAL IN WORLD HISTORY!"

US Secretary of State Marco Rubio has been reported as calling the deal "a huge

win for both the American and Venezuelan people," although details are still sketchy.

Venezuela's interim President, Delcy Rodríguez, is said to have hailed the deal, estimated to potentially earn her country over US\$200 billion, and expressed her "deep gratitude" to President Trump. She is reported as having said it would spur "our country's economic growth, the energy security of our hemisphere, and the greater balance of international markets."

Venezuela has the world's largest proven crude oil reserves with an estimated 303bn barrels, compared with Saudi Arabia's 268bn and Iran's 208bn.

DOWNSTREAM IMPACT

President Trump has said that the deal with Venezuela will substantially lower gas prices for all Americans. It comes at a time when concerns have been growing over America's dwindling oil reserve

stock, said to be at its lowest level in around 40 years. That has been attributed in part to the US's ongoing conflict with Iran, the blockage of the Strait of Hormuz, and other oil industry factors.

Some oil industry experts have been sounding an alarm about what they regard as the precarious situation of the US oil reserves, especially as the winter season approaches.

It has also been pointed out that domestic shortages in America would not only increase national demand and trigger a price increase at home. Such a scenario, it has been explained, could also have a significant downstream cost impact on those countries which buy their oil supplies from the US.

In that context, the Venezuela arrangement is seen as a sigh of relief not just for the US.

However, critics are questioning the na-

ture and circumstances surrounding the Venezuela/US deal, particularly in relation to recent and ongoing diplomatic developments between the two countries.

The US seized the former Venezuelan leader, Nicolas Maduro, and shipped him to the US in a daring raid in Caracas in January this year. The former Venezuelan strongman is presently imprisoned in the US where he is on trial on a series of drug-trafficking-related charges. The current Venezuelan leader, Delcy Rodriguez - who was Mr Maduro's deputy - had condemned his abduction by the US.

The Trump administration had also subsequently imposed a blockade on international oil trading with Venezuela and seized several tankers loaded with Venezuelan oil said to be violating the blockade. The situation surrounding that confiscated oil, said to be valued at around \$13 billion, remains unclear.



Court Rules Workers Were Employees and Entitled to Statutory Benefits

A significant judgment in a labour and employment matter has confirmed that a group of workers who provided services to Stingray Tours for a period spanning more than ten (10) years were, in law, employees of the company and therefore entitled to the protections and benefits provided under the applicable Labour Act.

The Department of Labour & Pensions (DLP) presented their case to the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions (ODPP) who took the case to court in early 2026. After a thorough investigation it was determined that the workers had maintained that, although they were compensated on a commission-based arrangement, the nature and duration of their relationship with the company demonstrated that they were employees rather than independent contractors. Over the course of their engagement, the workers were not provided with paid vacation leave or paid sick leave, benefits

generally available to employees under the Labour Act.

The company, however, took the position that the workers were not full-time employees and therefore were not enti-

tled to paid vacation or sick leave under the legislation.

After considering the evidence presented by both sides, the Court determined that the workers had provided sufficient evidence to establish that they were employees of the company. The Court therefore found that they were entitled to the applicable statutory benefits and protections under the Labour Act, notwithstanding the commission-based nature of their compensation.

As a result of the judgment, the company was subject to 10 criminal charges and was ordered to comply with the requirements of the Labour Act and to compensate the affected workers in accordance with the Court's determination, which resulted in a total of approximately CI\$86,230.00 in vacation pay and CI\$4,080.00 in sick leave pay. Additionally, the DLP continues its investigation relative to Pension non-compliance.

Minister for Labour Hon Michael Myles said, "This case sends a clear message that companies are on notice: the Labour Act must be respected and complied with. Employers cannot simply structure working arrangements in a particular way, to avoid their legal responsibilities or deprive workers of statutory rights and protections." He further stated, "I am particularly pleased that this matter demonstrates the value of holding employers accountable. I commend the entire Labour team at DLP for their work and dedication in investigating this matter which went to court which ultimately led to a successful prosecution and a significant outcome for the affected workers."

The public is also reminded that the Department of Labour and Pensions will continue to enforce the Labour Act and will act against employers who fail in their duty to ensure that employees receive the pension benefits to which they are legally entitled.

Russell focuses on last two hurdles

Masai Russell heads to Brussels this weekend chasing her first Diamond League title, just days after shattering the 100m hurdles World Record in Zurich.

The 100m hurdles Olympic champion will compete for her first Diamond League Trophy at the Brussels Diamond League Final this Saturday, 5 September. The event is also on Friday, 4 September.

Russell shattered the women's 100m hurdles record with a stunning 12.09 seconds. The 26-year-old American has won all 10 of the 100m hurdles finals she has competed in this season, including six victories on the 2026 Diamond League circuit.

"The job's not done yet," she said. "The only thing I'm thinking about right now is the next two races I've got to run. We still have a Diamond League Trophy to win. I've still got to win [World Athletics Ultimate Championships]."

The World Athletics Ultimate Championship is a new competition designed to bring the sport's biggest stars together for one final showdown at the end of the season.

It's in Budapest from 11-13 September. The inaugural edition of the event will pit Olympic champions, world champions and Diamond League winners against one another.

World Athletics president and Team GB Olympian, Sebastian Coe is fully backing this new competition.

The total purse at this year's meet will be \$10 million, with gold medallists winning \$150,000.

The championship features 28 events across three evening sessions. Unlike a traditional championship, there are no heats before every event.

Certain track disciplines will have two semi-finals before a final, while the 1500m, 5000m and relays are straight finals.

Garrett's trade surprise puts him in line for glory

When Myles Garrett recently learned he had been included in one of the biggest trades in NFL history, a wave of mixed emotions kicked in.

The Cleveland Browns sent the NFL's best defender to the Los Angeles Rams for budding star Jared Verse and three draft picks, ending Garrett's time with the franchise that drafted him No.1 overall in 2017.

Garrett claimed he was "shocked" but also added there was: "Joy. Disappointment. It was a little bit of everything. I was joyful about a new opportunity, going into a new place that's a great football team, great organisation, being able to challenge for a Super Bowl, being a contend-

er." During Garrett's nine seasons in Cleveland, the Browns missed the playoffs seven times, hampered by inconsistent quarterback play. With the Rams, he steps into a totally different situation.

The Rams lost the 2025 NFC Championship to the eventual Super Bowl champion Seattle Seahawks, but remain a strong contender given the roster's talent.

The 30-year-old Texan spent years playing at an elite level for the largely uncompetitive Browns. With the Rams, he should be just as great, anchoring a top-five defense. Only now, he'll finally have a real chance to add rings to his Hall of Fame resume.

Hrgovic schools Itauma to become IBF master

Heavyweight boxing has a new IBF champ in Filip Hrgovic yet it was his opponent who was expected to be the latest king.

Moses Itauma has been in the spotlight since he was embarrassing in sparring seasoned pros as a 15-year-old schoolboy. Fourteen straight wins, including 12 knockouts excited all and he was expected to roll Hrgovic over.

But on Saturday night at London's O2 Arena, the 21-year-old Brit was finally schooled, as he ran out of gas and the granite resolve of Hrgovic carried him to the vacant IBF title.

The referee waved off the fight as Itauma's corner threw in the towel in the ninth round. But for spells, Itauma dominated, repeatedly finding Hrgovic with big shots and showing why so many observers believed he would win easily.

But lack of experience and conditioning showed. An exhausted Itauma left the arena on a stretcher, before being taken to hospital.

Hrgovic, 34, spent fight week repeatedly mocking Itauma's age, dismissing

him as "just a kid". As the week wore on, Itauma became increasingly irritated and eventually lost his composure at the weigh-in, shoving Hrgovic before the Croatian responded with a slap. The tactic clearly worked.

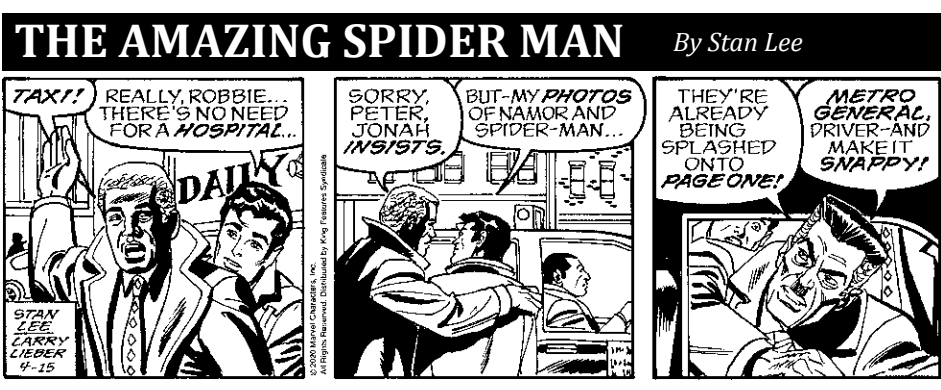

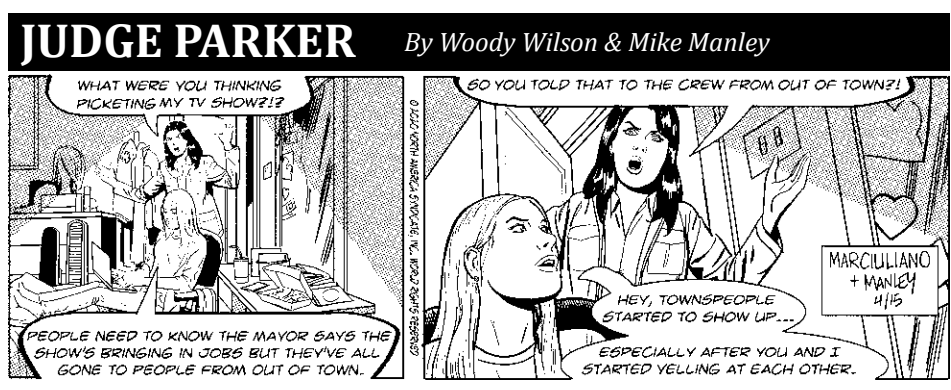
