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New youth cricket club aims to develop players

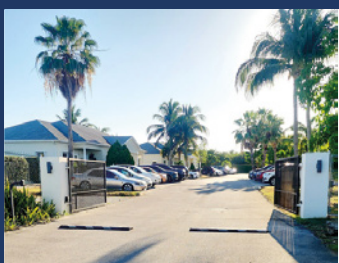
A new youth cricket club has launched in Cayman with a goal that extends beyond developing skills on the pitch.

Breast Cancer Foundation Announces 2026 Gala Guest Speaker

The Breast Cancer Foundation has announced that Dr. Corrine Ellsworth Beaumont, PhD MFA, will be the guest speaker for its 2026 Annual Gala on October 3rd, which will mark the organisation’s 17th anniversary.

Dr. Ellsworth Beaumont is the founder and CEO of Dandelion Health and the Know Your Lemons Foundation, a global charity focused on improving breast health education. She is known for using visual metaphors to teach breast cancer symptoms, screening, and diagnosis, helping to overcome taboos, fear, and literacy barriers that frequently delay early detection.

Since launching the foundation with her personal savings in 2017, Dr. Ellsworth Beaumont’s initiatives have reached more than 2 billion people globally. Her contributions include the Webby Award-winning Know Your Lemons app—which has been translated into over 40 languages—a volunteer educator network, and partnerships with hospitals, governments, and NGOs in more than 75 countries.

The Breast Cancer Foundation operates as part of this international network. All of the Foundation’s staff members are certified “Lemonistas.” In 2025, the local team conducted more than 90 Know Your Lemons classes throughout the Cayman Islands community, securing its position as a prominent leader within the global network.

Dr. Ellsworth Beaumont has participated in international panels, including the WHO Global Breast Cancer Initiative, and has pre-

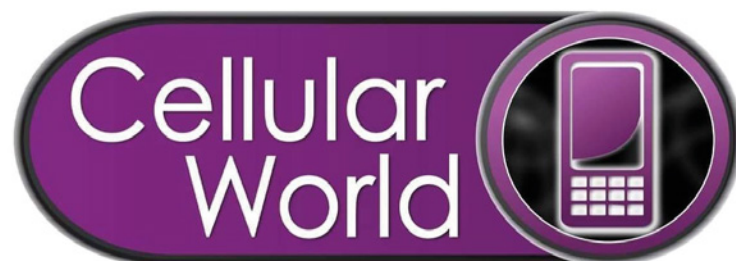
sented at the United Nations Conference and the World Cancer Congress. In 2025, Google recognized her as a featured app developer, highlighting her efforts in a short film for its We Are Play series. Her TEDx talk addressing the role of design in healthcare also earned a standing ovation.

“We are honoured to welcome Corrine to Cayman for our 2026 Gala,” said Beverly Edgington, Chief Operating Officer of the Breast Cancer Foundation. “Her work has redefined how the world talks about breast health, and her visit is a powerful affirmation of the ed-

ucation and early detection work our own team has championed here at home.”

The Breast Cancer Foundation’s Annual Gala is hosted each year to acknowledge ad-

vancements in breast cancer advocacy and to secure funding for wellness programmes, early detection initiatives, and patient care across the Cayman Islands.

Each organisation was chosen because its mission aligns with Rotary Sunset’s values: dignity, resilience, empowerment, and community uplift. The presentations were warm and heartfelt — Rotarians expressing gratitude, representatives sharing brief reflections, and the room responding with genuine applause.

Past President Patrick Schmid offered a message that resonated deeply with the club’s ethos. “These organisations serve

APPLEBY ADVISES ELDORADO DRILLING ON USD425M ACQUISITION FINANCING

Appleby has advised Eldorado Drilling (Eldorado), on the financing of its acquisition of Vantage Drilling International Ltd, a Cayman Islands exempted company, via a Nordic bond. Eldorado issued US\$425 million 9.125% senior secured bonds due 2026/2030. Net proceeds of the bond issue were used to finance the acquisition, refinance existing target debt and for general corporate purposes.

Fearnley Securities AS acted as Sole Global Coordinator and Joint Bookrunner, with Arctic Securities AS, DNB Carnegie, a part of DNB Bank ASA, and Pareto Securities AS acted as Joint Bookrunners for the bond issue. The bonds are to be listed on Euronext ABM.

Minister DaCosta to Engage Regional Leaders on Rehabilitation and Crime Reduction

Minister for District Administration and Home Affairs, the Hon. Nickolas DaCosta, JP, MP, will travel to Providenciales, Turks and Caicos Islands this week to support continued engagement with regional policymakers and probation, parole, rehabilitation, and community-corrections professionals.

The visit forms part of the Government's ongoing efforts to strengthen regional criminal justice cooperation, advance effective approaches to offender management and rehabilitation, and support safer communities by reducing reoffending.

Minister DaCosta will lead a Cayman Islands delegation to the 3rd Annual Caribbean Association of Probation and Parole (CAPP) Conference. The delegation will

participate in conference engagements from 2 to 4 September 2026 under the theme "Leveraging Probation, Parole and Rehabilitation as Effective Crime-Reduction Strategies in the Caribbean."

The Minister's itinerary includes participation in a Regional Leaders Panel Discussion alongside fellow Caribbean leaders. The discussion will focus on strengthening probation, parole, rehabilitation and community-based interventions as integral components of effective crime reduction and public safety.

Scheduled conference engagements include presentations and interactive sessions on evidence-based approaches to reintegration, case management, data governance, community supervision, youth

and family engagement, strategic planning and cross-agency collaboration.

The Minister will be accompanied throughout the visit by Deputy Chief Officer Lisa Malice; Acting Director of the Department of Community Rehabilitation Melissa Rivas; Senior Probation Officer Shakira Davis; and Administrative Officer Abigail Perez.

For the substantive period of Minister DaCosta's official travel, the Hon. Jay Ebanks, MP, will serve as Acting Minister for District Administration and Home Affairs.

Enterprise Cayman Launches FutureFocus Pathways to Connect Employer Demand with Caymanian Talent

New employer-led workforce development initiative combines paid workplace experience, targeted training and industry-recognised credentials to build skills for real workforce opportunities

Enterprise Cayman, the non-profit powered by Cayman Enterprise City (CEC), has launched FutureFocus Pathways, a new employer-led workforce development initiative designed to prepare Caymanian talent for real workforce opportunities by aligning training and practical experience directly with the skills businesses need.

Announced during a recent Radio Cayman interview, FutureFocus Pathways takes an employer-led approach, connecting talent development directly to real workforce demand. Enterprise Cayman works with participating Industry Partners to identify roles they need to fill or capabilities they want to develop, determine the technical and professional skills required to succeed, and build a tailored pathway to prepare suitable Caymanian candidates.

Participants undertake structured, paid four-to-six-month workplace placements alongside targeted hard-skills development, professional skills training and industry-recognised credentials, giving them the opportunity to build practical capabilities in a real working environment.

"As Cayman's economy expands into increasingly specialised industries, workforce development must be grounded in where the opportunities actually are," said Charlie Kirkconnell, CEO of Cayman Enterprise City and Chairman of Enterprise Cayman. "FutureFocus Pathways starts with employers: What roles do they need to fill? What skills and experience do those roles require? Where are the gaps? From there, we can build targeted pathways that combine on-the-job experience, technical and professional skills development, and industry-recognised credentials, giving Caymanians the practical capabilities they need to take advantage of those opportunities."

Each FutureFocus Pathway is co-designed with an Industry Partner around its specific workforce requirements. Participating employers help define the role, technical requirements, and workplace learning outcomes, while Enterprise Cayman supports candidate outreach, matching, participant preparation, structured training, and ongoing support throughout the placement.

Current pathways can support skills development in areas including project management, computer support, network systems administration, cloud infrastructure, and programming. However, the initiative is deliberately designed to respond to employer demand rather than being limited to a fixed catalogue of courses.

Working with global training partners including Dion Training, CompTIA and other established certification providers, Enterprise Cayman develops technical training pathways around specialised skills and credentials identified by participating employers.

FutureFocus Pathways is being launched as Cayman's evolving economy creates

growing demand for increasingly specialised skills.

Cayman Enterprise City's latest independent Socio-Economic Impact Assessment found that the number of Caymanians and Permanent Residents employed by Special Economic Zone companies (SEZCos) increased from 68 in 2020 to 172 in 2025, a 2.5-fold increase. Of those employees, 61% are working in professional and leadership roles.

The shift towards more specialised employment is also reflected in Enterprise Cayman's Jobs Portal. In 2025, 57% of opportunities advertised through the portal fell within occupations identified by the World Economic Forum as areas of employment growth, including roles in software engineering, compliance management, and systems analysis.

FutureFocus Pathways is designed to strengthen the connection between those emerging opportunities, and the skills Caymanian candidates need to compete for them.

While employment outcomes are an important ambition of the initiative, its immediate objective is broader: to ensure participants leave their pathway with stronger skills, meaningful workplace experience, recognised credentials, and greater employability, regardless of whether the placement immediately results in a job offer, promotion or salary increase.

"The goal is not simply to complete a course or a placement opportunity," said Alyssa Manderson, Programme Manager at Enterprise Cayman. "We want participants to finish with demonstrable skills, recognised credentials, meaningful workplace experience and a clearer understanding of what employers expect. Whether their next step is a new job, progression within an existing role or further training, they should leave the programme better prepared to take that step."

Among the first employers participating in FutureFocus Pathways is Kirk IT, an information technology support services provider and Rhetus International SEZC, a global contract research organisation serving academic, biotechnology, and pharmaceutical researchers. Rhetus has enrolled recent graduate Shanann Thompson in the programme, providing her with an opportunity to combine structured workplace experience with targeted professional development courses.

"For any knowledge-based business, developing people is one of the most important investments we can make," said Dr Frank Koentgen, Chairman of the Board at Rhetus International SEZC. "Qualifications can open the door, but practical skills, curiosity, and a willingness to continue learning are what allow people to build meaningful careers. We are pleased to participate in FutureFocus Pathways and to help develop emerging Caymanian talent against the skills and expectations of

an increasingly specialised global workforce."

FutureFocus Pathways builds on Enterprise Cayman's longstanding investment in workforce and skills development. Since 2012, the organisation has placed 177 interns and invested more than US\$1 million in programmes supporting skills development, entrepreneurship and career advancement.

The new initiative creates a more direct connection between that talent development work and the requirements of employers, giving businesses an active role in shaping the skills pipeline while providing Caymanian participants with opportunities to develop against clearly defined workplace needs.

"Ultimately, we want Caymanians to come out of FutureFocus Pathways demonstrably better prepared for what comes next," Kirkconnell said. "That could be securing a role, earning a promotion, increasing their earning potential or becoming qualified to pursue an entirely new career path. The goal is tangible progression, built around skills that employers genuinely value."

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Caribbean air travel plummets

Caribbean tourism continues to increase year-on-year but airline seat capacity in the region is in decline despite globally air travel increasing by 1.5 per cent.

The Caribbean recorded the second-largest decline in airline seat capacity in July globally after the Middle East when compared with year-earlier levels, according to the OAG, a UK-based travel analytics firm.

“Global capacity this month has increased by 8.3 million seats, compared to July 2025, equivalent to an increase of 1.5 per cent,” stated the OAG findings. Five regions globally, however, declined in July. Caribbean capacity fell 4.2 per cent year-on-year, a reduction of around 200,000 seats. The Middle East was down 7.0 per cent.

The Caribbean’s contraction for July continues a trend from earlier months. The decline comes amid the combined effects of Hurricane Melissa’s impact on hotel stock and airport infrastructure in Jamaica, the collapse of Spirit Airlines in May, rising fuel costs linked to the conflict in the Middle East, and Caribbean Airlines’ decision to cut unprofitable Eastern Caribbean routes.

Globally, capacity grew 1.5 per cent to 565.5 million seats, driven primarily by Europe, which added six million seats, and

North East Asia, which added 3.4 million. Central and Western Africa posted the fastest growth rate at 16.9 per cent.

Earlier this year LIAT’s then-CEO Julie Reifer-Jones said taxation was partly the problem. LIAT, she said, was now moving 750,000 passengers annually compared to one million in the past.

Reifer-Jones said: “The taxes are acting as a significant deterrent to travel across the region. Because we are connecting passengers across several territories, we are actually picking up taxes from three or four territories every time somebody flies from one destination to the next and we also have the issue of in transit taxes because we’re stopping at St Maarten or we’re stopping in St Vincent or we’re stopping in Barbados.”

She said that while LIAT 1974 had raised its base fare by only three per cent between 2009 and 2016, taxes had increased by about 56 per cent.

Trinidad’s new energy programs are working

Trinidad and Tobago’s commitment to renewable energy programs is growing significantly as it reduces its reliance on oil and gas.

New programs now have a more sustainable way of producing electricity and how it supports local communities. From national solar projects to rooftop systems in rural schools these efforts show how renewable energy can support economic diversification, local employment and ultimately reduce poverty.

Trinidad and Tobago historically relied heavily on oil revenue to support its economy. The country developed the Caribbean’s largest hydrocarbon industry, initially

through crude oil production and later through natural gas, liquefied natural gas and petrochemicals.

Despite its long dependence on oil and natural gas, Trinidad and Tobago has begun building a more diversified energy system. The country aims to generate 30 per cent of its electricity from renewable sources by 2030. It also seeks to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from the power generation, transportation and industrial sectors by 15 per cent.

Recent developments show how the country’s energy transition is expanding from small community installations to national electricity production.

Jamaica’s world renowned rum pedigree is going to hit the high notes because the Rolling Stones have produced their own brand out of the island.

The Stones are now marketing the latest version of Crossfire Hurricane Rum. Ian Burrell is Jamaica’s Global Rum Ambassador who helped create the final blend in collaboration with Mick Jagger and Keith Richards.

The Stones have a long history with Jamaican music and culture in general dating back to 1972, when they recorded their album ‘Goats Head Soup’ there. Like many British rockers at the time, they were fascinated by the burgeoning reggae scene there.

The first Crossfire Hurricane was a blend of rums from Barbados, the Dominican Republic, and Jamaica. The second one is all Jamaican, containing rums sourced from four of the island’s six distilleries: Long Pond, Hampden Estate, Clarendon, and Worthy Park. Jamaican rum has pretty strict laws attached to it, so no sugar or other flavourings can be added after distillation. It retails for roughly \$40 and connoisseurs and the public alike are impressed.

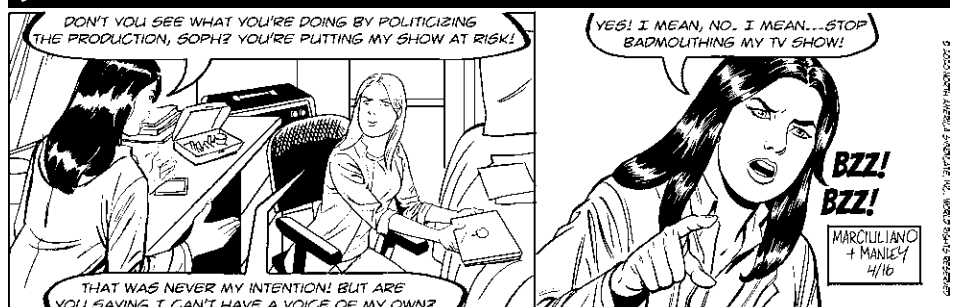

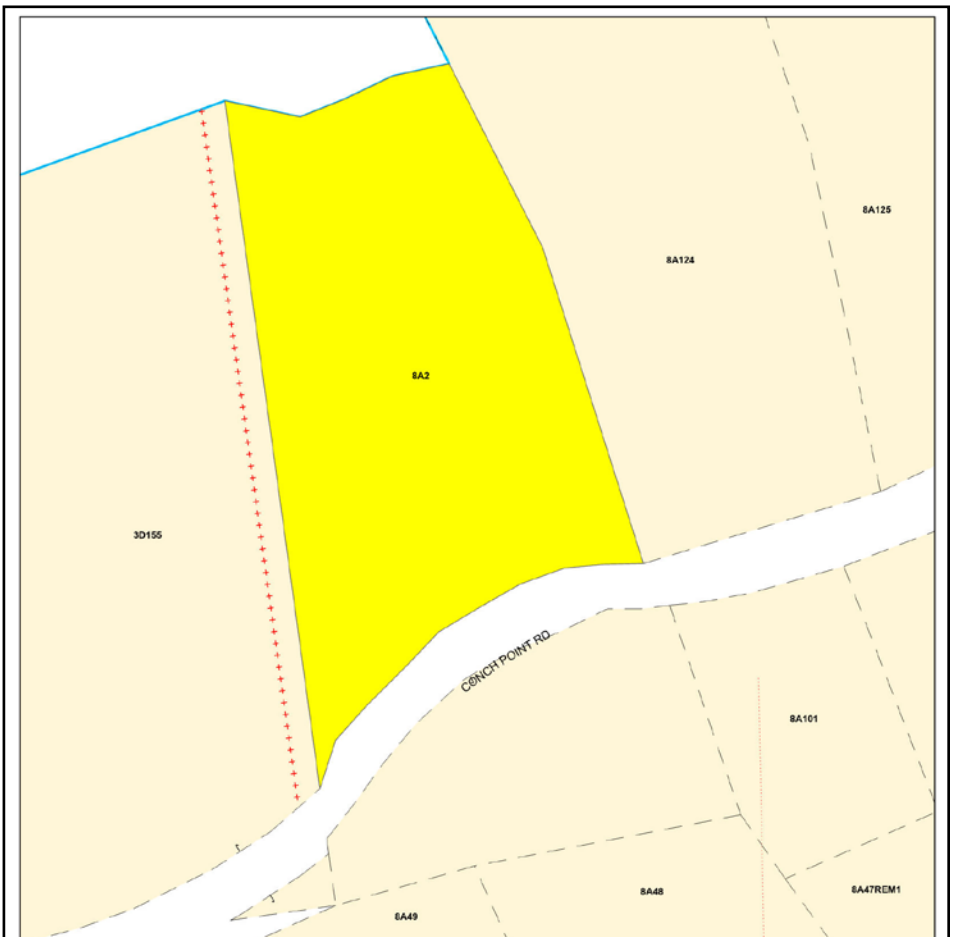
